Program Objectives

- Helping APPP students graduate high school
- Improving birth outcomes by increasing pregnant teens access to prenatal care services
- Preparing teens to parent
- Decreasing teen repeat pregnancies
- Improving opportunities for parenting teens to be financially independent and self-sufficient

APPP Services

A pregnant or parenting student in TUHSD has two educational options. They may choose to **stay on their home campus** and attend classes as part of the general student body. Case management, counseling and support groups are provided by the APPP staff.

A more comprehensive setting is the Teenage Pregnancy Program (TAPP) **located at Marcos de Niza (MdN)** an open enrollment campus. Academic credit is earned through classes at MdN and an elective credit is earned through classes specifically designed for the pregnant and parenting teenager. Comprehensive case management service are offered to all students participating in TAPP.

- Parenting teens
- Children of teen parents
- Teens at risk of pregnancy
