## Theatre & Technical Theatre Tracks

The *THEATRE* & *TECHNICAL THEATRE* tracks offer students a variety of courses, building strong foundations in performance, visual design, college and/or career preparation, and portfolio development.

**THEATRE TRACK:** The MdN Theatre program is an award-winning, highly recognized program in Arizona that wants to provide students with performance skills in ensemble work, improvisation, movement, mime, voice, storytelling, character work, play analysis, site theatre, invisible theatre, makeup design, troupe work, theatre through literacy, theatre history, playwriting, directing, film projects, special projects and community outreach. *Honors options are available*. Completion of the Theatre Track requires a minimum of 5 credits:

- 3 credits in Theatre (1 credit can be Honors level)
- 1 credit in Tech Theatre or Film Study
- 1 credit in Vocal Ensemble (for vocal training)
- 1 credit in Dance (for movement training and considered your PE credit)

**TECHNICAL THEATRE TRACK:** The Technical Theatre track is aligned with the Arizona Career & Technical Education (CTE) state standards in order to provide a well-rounded curriculum in design, scenery, costumes, properties, rigging, lighting, sound, stage management, stage jobs/careers, and marketable workplace skills. In addition, students will receive hands-on opportunities with design, creation, management and execution through our three annual theatrical productions: Fall play, Spring musical and the Night of Shorts. Completion of the Technical Theatre Tracks requires a minimum of 5 credits:

- 4 credits in Technical Theatre (1 credit can be in Theatre or Film Study)
- 1 Credit in Visual Arts (preferably Art & Design)
- (suggested) 1 Credit in Construction Tech 1-2
