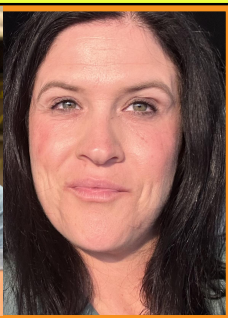

Tuesday 4/9: ACT Testing

Only Juniors will be on campus for testing, all other grade levels will have a digital learning day.

Tuesday 4/16 & Thursday 4/18: ACT Aspire Testing Part 1 and 2

All Freshmen will take this test; all other grade levels will follow a modified schedule after the testing window. More details about this schedule to follow.

Registration for the 24-25 School Year- April 26th is the last day to make schedule request changes!

Students may still come in for counseling regarding next year's schedule between now and **April 26th**. This is the time to reflect on choices, review postsecondary plans, and make sure next year's choices meet our academic and interest goals. Counselor walk-in times for students is before school, during lunch, and after school. Students may also email their counselor. When the fall semester begins, we will only make schedule changes for the following reasons:

1. **Missing a class period**
2. **Missing a lunch period**
3. **Course was already completed**
4. **Level change Honors to on-level (if space is available)**

Lunch changes, teacher requests, class changes to be with friends, and class period changes will **NOT be honored**. The computer assigns the lunch period based on the schedule. We are not able to change student lunch hours.
