UPDATED: CCPS Updates Safety Measures for Athletic Events to Expand Student Participation

JONESBORO - In response to feedback from our community, the district has adjusted the recently communicated enhanced safety measures for athletic events. These changes aim to allow students broader opportunities to participate in games beyond their immediate school community while maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment. The Clayton County Public Schools' Athletics Department remains committed to implementing all necessary safety protocols.

The updated attendance requirements are as follows:

- **High School Students:** Must present their school-issued identification card to gain entry to any sporting event. They are permitted to attend games or activities involving their school or other high schools, provided they have their school-issued identification card.
- **Elementary and Middle School Students:** Must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. No drop-offs are allowed.

These revised attendance conditions will take effect immediately.
