- Schedule parent/teacher conferences as needed and/or requested by the teacher or parent using the compact as it relates to the individual child's achievement. Parents may schedule a conference via phone, email, written notice, or ClassDojo.
- Encourage and provide opportunities for parent involvement through our parent volunteer program and other school-wide activities throughout the school year.
- Stemley Road Elementary School regularly sends home letters and automated calls to inform parents of school activities and events. TransAct is used to communicate written notifications to parents in their native language. In addition, the school website, Twitter feed, and SRES Facebook page are used to increase communication and share school-related information with parents. Ongoing communication is provided by phone, email, written communication, and ClassDojo.
