Per Board Policy IGCD and IGCD-AP1: Students can be enrolled in online courses unless there is a determination with the student's home school that there is good cause to refuse the student enrollment in the course.

As a parent/guardian, I will

1. Remain in regular communication with the teacher for clarity on procedures, schedule, synchronous online meetings, or any other items pertinent to the success of my child.
2. Understand there may be set times every day that my child will be expected to be online for live class events.
3. Hold my child accountable for assignment/assessment due dates and late work policies set by their teachers.
4. Understand that my student will be enrolled for at least one semester through the Online Academy.
5. Hold my child accountable for his/her online behavior, per the Student Handbook (Acceptable Use Contract).
6. Create a designated space for school work that is distraction-free and conducive to learning, especially for live online group discussions and class meetings.
7. Understand there may be materials that need to be picked from my child's school to assisting them in completing learning activities.
8. Understand that my child will be required to complete all district, state, and national assessments. State and national assessments will need to be completed on-site at the same time as other grade-level peers.
9. Understand that if my student is not successful in online coursework, they will be required to return to in-person instruction or dropped from the online program after 10 inactive days.
