Goals for Our Students

2024-2025 LCBOE District Goals

Goal 1: Increase the percentage of students reading on grade level based on district formative assessments, i.e. MAP, Lexile levels from the 2024-2025 beginning of the school year data so that at least 75% of students are considered proficient at the end of the 2024-2025 school year.

Goal 2: During the 2024- 2025 school year, increase the percentage of students scoring at a proficient or distinguished level on the Math GMAS as compared to 2023-2024 school year percentiles.

Goal 3: Increase 2024-2025 school year percentages of all subgroup populations scoring at the proficient level on GMAS ELA and Math assessments by 3% over 2023-2024 school year proficient level percentages.

Goal 4: Increase or maintain 2024-2025 school year climate ratings at each school as compared to 2023-2024 ratings by utilizing support resources available.

School Goals:

Goal 1: During the FY25 school year, 65% of WLM students will score an average of 2.2 or higher on the extended writing component of the GMAS.

Focus Skill: Increasing writing skills – elaboration and sentence structure

Goal 2: During the FY25 school year 90% or more of WLM students will score a 2 or higher on the mathematics GMAS.
