

BOARD VISITATION TO SCHOOLS

Members of the board are encouraged to visit schools. Such visits shall be made in accordance with the following guidelines:

School visits shall be scheduled through the building principal.

The principal or designee may accompany the board member on the visit if the member so desires.

Such visits will be for the purpose of becoming acquainted with school programs, personnel, operations, and facilities.

A board member will not give directions, or make suggestions to personnel during the visit. If a school visit leaves a board member with a concern, this concern should be addressed through appropriate channels, i.e., discussed with the principal and/or the superintendent of schools.

A board member may visit a school as a parent. The member should make his or her status clear at the beginning of the visit.
