WHAT IS MTSS AT AGCS?

- An instructional framework that includes screening all students, data analysis, and multiple tiers of instruction and support services.

- Assessments are conducted three times a year: fall, winter, and spring using Exact Path and Acadience measures.
- MTSS score reports will be available to parents after each benchmark period through Parent Portal.

TARGETED INTERVENTIONS

- Students who qualify for a targeted intervention will receive notification from the interventionist, via email.
- Interventions are mostly held directly in the classroom during small group instruction.
- Students receiving intervention do not miss core instruction.

SMALL GROUP TIER 2 SUPPORT

- Interventionists also push into classrooms to run small groups that focus on specific skills.
- These groups are flexible and students may be placed in and out of these groups based on need.
- This occurs during small group time in the classroom.

CLASSWIDE INTERVENTIONS

• Classwide interventions occur daily in the classroom to meet all students' needs in math and reading, with the classroom teacher.
