Dear Poff Families,

On September 20th, we will train students on the ALICE procedures for school safety. ALICE

stands for Alert, Lockdown, Counter, Inform, Evacuate. These procedures are used in many

school districts in Western Pennsylvania and across the nation. The students will be in their

homerooms for this training and will learn about ALICE in a way that is developmentally

appropriate for their grade level. All students will hear the story I'm Not Scared, I'm Prepared,

by Julia Cook, which explains ALICE. They will then have an opportunity to ask questions about

what they learned.

Following the training, we will have a school safety drill. During this time, students will use

what they have learned about ALICE. Elementary students will not counter during school safety

drills. They will practice following the teacher's direction to either lockdown or evacuate. It is

our intention that by using this developmentally appropriate training, students will learn that

ALICE is a tool they could use to keep themselves safe in any location if the situation called for

it. Great care has been, and will continue to be, taken to assure that this information is presented

in a way that is empowering and not frightening for our students. Should you have any questions,
