- Parents/guardians are invited and encouraged to attend conferences, PTO/SIC meetings, award programs, and athletic events!

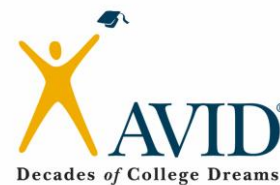

Tools to Enhance Student Success



Organization is Key

- Make a checklist of items your child needs to take to school every day. This will include textbooks, library books, IDs, paper, AVID binder or notebook, and pencils. Pack backpacks at night to ensure all items are accounted for and are ready for school the next morning.
- Students must organize and read over/study their classroom focused notes 20-30 minutes daily. They should do this whether their teacher assigns it as homework or not.

Time Management

- Track assignments on a monthly calendar. Then, check off each item as it is completed. Break large assignments into nightly tasks.
