STUDENT ILLNESS

- I. The Nurse, Principal, and Unlicensed Assistive personnel shall isolate a student who becomes ill while at school until the student can be removed to his/her home. A student with a temperature at or above 100 degrees, diarrhea, or emesis shall be evaluated and sent home.
- II. A student who has had a serious communicable disease shall present a written statement from a physician licensed by the state of Florida before being readmitted to classes.
- III. No medication of any kind may be given to a student without the written permission of the parent(s), as defined by Florida Statutes.
