



# 1. The \$50M Bond Anticipation Note (BAN) sale closed on 8/29/24.


- Short-term

May River Elementary School (Quackenbush Architects and Planners/TTC)

- Cost review took place on August 30, 2024; TTC is preparing the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) Proposal that is scheduled to be submitted to the District for review in September 2024
- Board approval of TTC's GMP Amendment is scheduled to be requested in October 2024
- Civil permits are ongoing; Site permit is scheduled to be received in November 2024



- CTE equipment reviews are ongoing for approval of proposed equipment
- Land Disturbance Permit is scheduled to be received in December 2024

### Hilton Head Island High School (Little Diversified Architectural Consulting, Inc./MBK)





Phase 1: Contractual Substantial Completion date is June 19, 2026

**Hilton Head Island High School** 

• Site Work: Redesign of water and sewer service (due to unforeseen issues with existing underground piping) is scheduled to be completed in September 2024

(Little Diversified Architectural Consulting, Inc./MBK)

- Phase 1A: Scope includes construction of a 3-story classroom addition (approximately 144,000 SF) and a mechanical support building; Installation of aggregate piers were completed in August 2024; Foundations started in August 2024 and are approximately 25% completed
- Phase 1B: Scope includes selective demolition and initial renovations of the "D" wing (Music & Art); Scope includes group restroom improvements, modifications of corridor walls and finishes; Phase 1B construction is scheduled to commence in June 2025







**Phase 2:** Target Substantial Completion date to be established in December 2024 when CD's have been completed

- Phase 2 scope includes the demolition of the "B" and "C" wings (Academic Spaces); Construction
  of a new cafeteria and CTE addition; Remaining renovations/improvements for the "D" wing
  (Music and Fine Arts); New parking lot and courtyard
- Construction Documents (CD's) are approximately 75% complete; Progress review meeting took place with school staff in August 2024; Progress review with District IT staff is scheduled to occur in September 2024; 100% CD's are scheduled to be completed prior to the end of December 2024
- GMP Proposal is scheduled to be received in Q1 2025





**Phase 3:** Target Substantial Completion date to be established in December 2024 when CD's have been completed

(Little Diversified Architectural Consulting, Inc./MBK)

- Phase 3 scope includes renovation of both existing gymnasiums, existing JROTC and existing cafeteria
- Construction Documents (CD's) are approximately 75% complete; Progress review meeting took place with school staff in August 2024; Progress review with District IT staff is scheduled to occur in September 2024; 100% CD's are scheduled to be completed prior to the end of December 2024
- GMP Proposal is scheduled to be received in Q1 2025


