- ¹ The school districts listed in the table have comparable elementary school enrollments to the Wausau School District and offer similar grade levels. These districts rank from 9th to 17th in size among Wisconsin's school districts by elementary enrollment, with the Wausau School District positioned 13th. The two districts in this size range not included in the table are the Middleton-Cross Plains Area School District, which serves only grades 4K-4 in its elementary schools, and the Stevens Point Area Public School District, which serves grades 4K-6 in its elementary schools.
- ² Elementary school enrollments for each school district are from the most recent year available, either the 2022-23 academic year or 2023-24 academic year.
- ³ Some school districts report their capacity figures as a range, while others provide them as a single number. This column represents functional capacity wherever possible.
- ⁴ Starting in the 2024-25 academic year, the Oshkosh Area School District is operating 12 elementary schools. This adjustment follows the closure of three elementary schools in June 2024 and the opening of a new school in September 2024 for students from the closed schools. The figures shown in this table are from the 2023-24 academic year, when the Oshkosh Area School District operated 14 schools with a total elementary school capacity of 4,743 students.
