Ashley is a 2008 graduate of JHS. While at JHS, she was a member of the Basketball, Cheer, Softball, and Volleyball teams. During her four years, she was voted First Team All-District for softball in 2005, District Defensive Player of the year in 2006 and 2007, Johnson County Outfielder of the Year in 2005, 2006 and 2007, First Team Fort-Worth Super Team in 2007 and 2008, Offensive Player of the Year in 2008, Johnson County Most Valuable Player in 2008, and First Team All-State Outfielder in 2008. Ashley was a member of the 2008 softball team who made it to the class 4A Regional Finals. After high school, Ashley attended Oklahoma Baptist University on a softball scholarship from 2009 - 2012.
