

2024 CAPITAL PROJECTS

Levy Facts



- 1 The tax rate is estimated to stay the same as the current tax rate.** The proposed Capital Levy will keep the total local school tax rate at \$2.34 per thousand assessed value for 2025 & 2026. Starting in 2027 the Capital Levy rate is planned to decrease significantly in anticipation of future proposals.
- 2 Levy recommendations are community-informed.** Projects proposed in the Capital Projects Levy are based on recommendations from the Facilities Advisory Committee (FAC). FAC members include community, staff, and parents who have studied facility conditions, consulted with facilities experts, and identified proposed solutions. Visit nkschools.org/fac to learn more.
- 3 The recommendations of the FAC have been made with future capital proposals in mind.** Efficient use of taxpayer dollars is a high priority for the FAC and the district. Major improvements made with this Capital Levy will not need to be redone (reworked or replaced) if future capital measures are approved by voters.

PROPOSED PROJECTS

The levy would support **improvements at all North Kitsap schools**, including:



SAFETY & SECURITY

Secure main entry systems, traffic/parking lot flow improvements, perimeter fencing, lighting and cameras



BUILDING SYSTEMS

HVAC and mechanical system improvements, exterior painting and sealing, asphalt and parking lot repairs, door re-keying



ACCESSIBILITY

Gym addition to Hider Pearson ES, additional classrooms at Suquamish ES, athletics and playground improvements, accessible paths



TECHNOLOGY

Chromebook/device replacements, educational software renewals, infrastructure improvements
