We are pleased to announce we have the following new swim teachers joining us - Callum, Erin, Teddy, Micheal and Heilco.



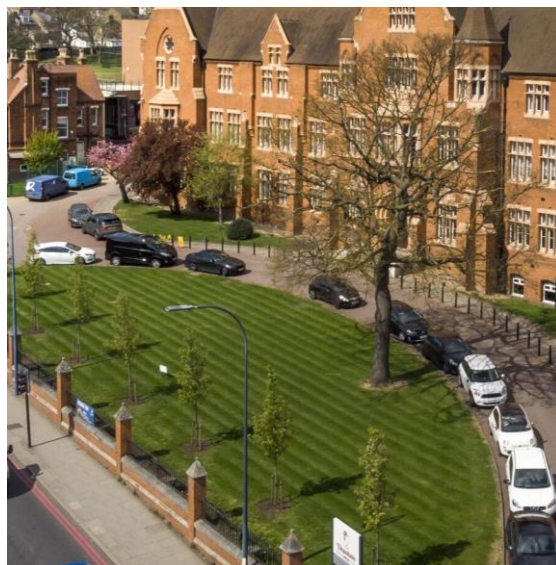
Badges & Certificates
