## Deadlines Approaching

### **PSAT/SAT Testing Day – 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Registration Deadline Today!**

Wednesday, October 30<sup>th</sup> is a school wide testing day for the PSAT/SAT. 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will be automatically registered to test for free.

Because 11<sup>th</sup> grade students can only take the PSAT on Wednesday, October 30<sup>th</sup>, we will offer an SAT School Day administration on Wednesday, October 16<sup>th</sup> for 11<sup>th</sup> grade students only. The deadline for 11<sup>th</sup> graders to register and pay to take the PSAT/NMSQT and the SAT is Friday, September 13<sup>th</sup>.

Please be sure the current graduate is approximately the same height and weight as the previous grad to ensure proper fit of the gown.
