We love our Lakeland students and their families. There are many ways to be involved in your child's school year:

This year we will once again be holding our "We Are Lakeland" School/Parent meetings. These will be held three times throughout the school year:

All meetings will be held in the STEM room and will begin at 4:00pm. The agendas of the meetings will center on our school Title 1 goals giving parents the chance for feedback on those areas as well as help give ideas for school events.



In order to learn, we need your child at school! If you are having a hard time getting your child to school (or getting him/her to school on time), please reach out. We are here to help! The following attendance policies will be followed:

- Three unexcused absences will result in a truancy referral with Kandiyohi County.
- After ten illness days, a doctor's note will be required to excuse a child as sick. Without a note, it will be an excused absence.

If your child will not be in school, please remember to call the attendance office.

SAFETY FIRST

Your child's safety is important to us. Because of that, please have your ID ready when you are picking up your child. Only adults who are listed on our Campus/Parent Portal system will be allowed to check a student out of school.

If you have custody restrictions, please get the paperwork to the office to ensure our information is up to date.

During the school year, we will be practicing safety drills with the adults and students. Our hope is to be prepared in case of any type of emergency. We will practice various drills and scenarios. Some of the drills will be practiced with staff only. More information will be coming throughout the year.

Beginning/End of the Day Procedures:

Our doors open at 8:15 for student arrival. Buses enter the back parking lot, and students enter through the back doors. Parent drop off happens in the front of the school. Please do not leave your car when dropping off students in the drop off lane. If you wish to walk your child into school, please park your car in the parking lot.

Student dismissal time is 3:20 for K-5. Students riding the bus home will leave from the back of the school. Our goal is to have buses leaving the school by 3:25. Parent pick up happens in the front of the school. Students line up by their grade level colored flag. Please continue to pull ahead when waiting in line. Do not leave your car unattended in the pick up line. Please use the parking lot to leave your car if you wish to walk up and get your child.

PLEASE ONLY USE DESIGNATED PARKING SPOTS IN THE LOTS. THIS INCLUDES LEAVING THE HANDICAPPED SPACES FOR THOSE WITH SPEICALLY IDENDIFIED VEHICLES.

BE PATIENT AND WATCH FOR CHILDREN. PLEASE DEMONSTRATE KINDNESS IN THE PARKING LOT. WE WANT ALL KIDS TO GET HOME SAFELY.
