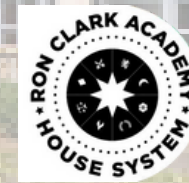

District Goals

- Increase the percentage of all students scoring proficient or distinguished on Reading Milestones
- Increase the percentage of all students scoring proficient or distinguished on Math Milestones

College Park Elementary Goals

- **K-2ND:** By May 2025, Students will increase their iReady Reading and Math scores by 5%.
