


Verona Area School District

Verona Area School District (VASD) has been gathering community feedback relating to a variety of topics to inform future district communication plans, continuous improvement plans, and the strategic direction of the district. During the 2022-23 academic year, VASD partnered with Hanover Research (Hanover) to design, administer, and analyze the results of a district Culture and Climate Survey. In this infographic, Hanover presents key findings of the survey for community members.




Respondents By School Level




KEY FINDINGS: SCHOOL SAFETY

Compared to last year, more respondents agree with statements regarding school safety. However, student responses related to school safety continue to be less positive than responses form parents and staff. Across most areas, respondents indicate that students experience bullying less often compared to last year. Characteristics that students experience bullying/harassment for most often include race/ethnicity/skin color, gender identity or expression, and physical appearance.



The percentage of students who experience bullying or harassment only <u>A Few Times a Year</u> or <u>Almost Never</u> based on their...




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KEY FINDINGS: STUDENT ENGAGEMENT

While students and staff still have different perceptions of student attitudes toward learning compared to last year, student perceptions have increased for all questions related to student attitudes toward learning. Additionally, respondents generally report that adults at school treat students well, although they are less likely to agree that adults consistently or fairly enforce school rules.




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KEY FINDINGS: ACADEMIC SUPPORTS


Overall, respondents continue to have positive perceptions of the instructional climate at VASD schools. Similar to last year, more than three-quarters of respondents agree that their school provides enough resources and wants students to succeed, while more than two-thirds agree that their school provides a well-rounded curriculum and sets high expectations.



KEY FINDINGS: CONSTITUENT ENGAGEMENT

Although the overall impression of respondents regarding the district's culture and climate has improved compared to last year, many respondents do not feel positive about communication and do not feel well-informed about the direction of the district going forward. Compared to last year, fewer parents agree that they feel informed about the direction of VASD (30% compared to 37%) but more staff agree that they feel informed (48% compared to 36%). More than half of parents continue to agree that VASD has a culture of two-way communication.





Please indicate how much you disagree or agree with the following statement: % Somewhat Agree or Strongly Agree


