Tuition Assistance

TUITION ASSISTANCE

The Willows Community School is committed to enrolling students from diverse economic, ethnic, racial, and social backgrounds. As part of that commitment, the school is able to grant tuition assistance based solely on demonstrated financial need and determined by the annual budgeting set by the Board of Trustees.

The Willows Community School is dedicated to designating funds from its annual operating budget for tuition assistance, which is available for qualifying families. Tuition assistance application forms are available on our website at: <https://www.thewillows.org/admissions/tuition-assistance>.

Completed Tuition Assistance Forms are due by January 27, 2025.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who may apply for tuition assistance? Anyone may apply for assistance. Applying for assistance, however, does not guarantee a grant will be offered.

How is “demonstrated need” determined? Need is determined by The Willows Community School Tuition Assistance Committee, which uses tax returns, confidential statements, and Clarity for tuition assistance as a tool to help in the decision making process.

How and when do I apply for tuition assistance?

All tuition assistance forms are available on our website under Admissions/Tuition Assistance/Forms & Due Dates.

Will applying for tuition assistance affect my child's chances for admission? No. It is important to note that applying for tuition assistance has no bearing upon the Admission Committee's assessment and decision. Decisions regarding admission to the school and eligibility for tuition assistance are made independently of one another.

Does our family have to repay the tuition award? No. Tuition assistance is an outright award used to offset the cost of tuition at The Willows Community School.

How confidential is the tuition assistance application process? All applications for tuition assistance are held in strict confidence. Only the Business Manager and the Tuition Assistance Committee of the Board of Trustees have access to the records.

How will our family be notified of our tuition award? A letter of acceptance from the Admissions Office will include instructions on how to access your enrollment contract, which will indicate the amount of your award, information about deposits and fees, and options for payment.
