His remarkable coaching achievements, combined with his dedication to student-athletes and coaches, make him the clear choice for this role.

Dodge brings a wealth of experience to his new position, having previously served as Offensive Coordinator and Quarterback Coach at Northwest High School and Marcus High School. Prior to coaching at the high school level, Dodge worked as an Offensive Analyst at the University of Texas and as a Graduate Assistant at Texas A&M University. As a college athlete, he played at the University of North Texas and McNeese State University earning numerous accolades including Sun Belt All-Conference Quarterback honors, and the Shawn Kramer Most Inspirational Player Award. A former standout Dragon quarterback himself, Dodge was part of three state championship teams and was named Texas High School Player of the Year in both 2006 and 2007, MaxPreps National Player of the Year in 2006, and a Parade All-American in 2007.

Dodge and his wife, Alexis, are both Carroll graduates. They have four children: Tate (9), Landry (6), Blakely (4) and Charlotte (6 months).

“Coach Dodge has proven himself to be a dedicated and visionary leader both on and off the field. His passion for the development of our student-athletes and his commitment to our district’s values make him the perfect choice for this expanded role.
