Equity By Design

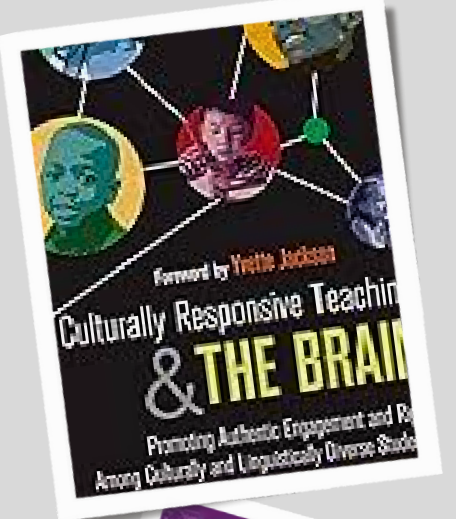
