## Rank/Grade Point Average:

Class rank and grade point averages are weighted. All Advanced Placement courses will be weighted, resulting in a grading scale of 4.333. A student’s rank in class is based on her/his grade point average (GPA), which is calculated from all classes taken, grades 9-12. To accurately reflect student achievement, summative assessments are the primary source in calculating a student’s grades versus formative assessments. Summative assessments include test scores and quizzes, projects, research papers, essays, and performances. Formative assessments (i.e., homework completion, attendance, participation, behavior) are not factored into a student’s final grade.

## Schedule

De Pere uses a 7-period schedule with limited options to take an additional 0-hour course and a 30-minute Nest/Flex daily.
