What your Kindergartener is Learning:

Language Arts

Domain: We will read a story about Helen Keller this week.

This week we will review and take our tests on the five senses. **The study guide went home.**

Skills: We have started learning the sounds. In these lessons students will learn words that start with the sound, how to write the sound, and movements for the sounds.



This week we are working on the following sounds: “n,” “h,” “s.”

Math

We will continue to talk about greater than and less than with numbers up to 5. We will look at different groups and decide which is bigger or smaller. We will also talk about equal groups.
