The Grauer School, a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, began in a borrowed storefront and has been under constant development by parents, grandparents and community members who have chosen to advance our unique and vibrant vision. Gifts to the school, in any amount, support the mission and are tax-deductible.

Approximately fifteen to twenty percent of The Grauer School budget is covered by philanthropic giving. Parents are our most important and active members of our school and there are many ways to give back, including with your **time, treasure** and **talent**.

Non-financial giving at Grauer is also vital and includes a wide range of services: board governance, legal services, marketing, volunteerism, and more. We honor the countless hours and acts of generosity given by school parents every year.

FINANCIAL GIVING: Your Gift Matters.

We ask every family to make Grauer a philanthropic priority while your child is here. There are three opportunities during the school year to participate and support financially: Annual Fund (fall), Endowment Funds (winter), and Gala (spring).



Another area of critical importance is providing needbased financial aid: our Access to Grauer Endowment Fund.

Currently, 23% of our students receive financial aid and a total of nearly \$500,000 was awarded for the 2024-2025 school year. The most important work that we can do is provide equitable access to this school. Help us reach new heights!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why should my family give?

Here's the bottom line: your gift supports the people and programs that make Grauer so special. As a non-profit, tuition covers the school experience but philanthropy allows us to do amazing things like hands-on projects, expeditionary learning, support professional development and prioritize face-to-face connection.

How many times will I be asked to give?

Grauer has three opportunities to give:

- Annual Fund Fall
- Endowments Winter
- Gala Spring

Our top priority is the Annual Fund, and we ask for 100% participation on Giving Day. Many families may choose to make multiple gifts throughout the year.

How much should I give?

Does a small gift really make a difference?

Absolutely! When participation rates are strong, it is an indicator of our school's collective commitment to inspire each student's unique potential and also inspires giving from the outside community. We ask that you make Grauer a philanthropic priority, and we know that this looks different for every family.

- Average annual giving in 2023-2024 was \$950 per family.
- Leadership gifts of \$2,000+ really transform our school.
