First Day of School

The first day of school for all students is Tuesday, September 3. **Students will be welcomed into the building starting at 7:35 am** for our 8:00 am start time. All students need to bring with them is a backpack! Reusable water bottles are welcome, too.

We are excited to provide our newest Royals a VIP experience on their first day of 6th grade! 6th Graders will be greeted by our WEB (Where Everyone Belongs) student leaders and escorted into a VIP entrance to help ensure their first day of middle school is a success.

School Supplies

We provide all scholars with school supplies to ensure that all students have the supplies they need at school to be successful. Student Drop Off and Pick Up Area

Please review the student drop off/pick up area for students who are transported by car to and from school. We know the first day of school is an important milestone and that many families like to drive their child to school. I want to encourage you to have your child ride the bus on the first day because of our limited space here at our temporary school location. The drop off/pick up loop has limited space and cars that back up on to the main road will cause significant traffic delays for our buses and the community around us. We appreciate your patience and pre-planning so we can help all 670 of our students arrive to school safely!



Bus Transportation to and from our temporary location is provided for all students that live in our service area. Students on Choice enrollment must provide their own transportation.

Important information for parents that choose to drop off/pick up their child:

- Enter the parent/family loop area only. Follow the red arrows on the map above
- Follow the cones to join the pick up/drop off line
- Remain in your car. Scholars will exit/enter cars at the designated pick up/drop off location
- In the morning, students can exit cars & enter the building after 7:35 AM. School begins at 8:00 AM
- School is dismissed at 2:30 PM on regular school days and at 1:15 PM on Early Release Fridays

Fall Sports Begin Tuesday, 9/3

Our fall sports teams will begin practice on the first day of school on Tuesday, 9/3. The fall season includes Football for 7th and 8th graders, Boys and Girls Cross Country, and Fastpitch. All scholar-athletes must be cleared for practice in order to participate. Athletic clearance includes having an updated sports physical in the last 2 years that's on file with our Main Office and all the necessary forms completed in Final Forms. Please reach out to our Main Office with questions - 253-945-4600.

For Football and Cross Country, students will be bused after school to our original Illahee field that is located next to our building that is under construction. Families will need to pick up their child from this location. Coaches will provide more specific details to families.

For Fastpitch, students will be bused to Todd Beamer High School's fastpitch field for practice and home games. Families will need to pick up their child from this location. Coaches will provide more specific details to families.

Bus Routes

Bus routes are now updated and posted in ParentVue. If your student is a bus rider, you should have received an email or text from Transportation Wednesday evening with your most current bus route information. If you did not receive a notification, please check ParentVue where you can find your child's route information under the "student info" tab. Please make sure to have your child at the bus stop 5 minutes prior to the pick up time. For all transportation-related questions, please call the transportation office at 253-945-5960.

Student Cell Phone and Earbuds/Headphones

Personal Electronics/Technology (cell phone) use at Illahee

This year, in order to maintain a focus on learning, we want to remind families about our student expectations regarding personal electronics/technology while at school. We know that a large number of students have cell phones and other electronic devices however, cell phones and electronics cause distractions, interrupt classroom instruction, and can impact the safety of our students. **Students at Illahee are expected to keep cell phones put away at all times during the school day except during lunchtime**. Other types of electronic devices (earbuds, headphones, etc.) should be kept at home. Students who do not follow this expectation will be subject to school discipline.

Recommendations for families:

- · Review this information with your student at home
- We urge families to communicate with students before (7:30) or after school (2:30).
- If families need to contact their student(s) while at school, call the main office at (253)-945-4600
- For non-emergencies such as transportation changes, our staff will deliver messages to students when it does not disrupt class time
- · Students have access to school phones if they need to contact you
