CogAT Testing

Your third-grade child will be taking the Cognitive Ability Test (CogAT). The CogAT measures a student's potential problem-solving skills in the areas of verbal ability (word analogies and sentence completion), quantitative ability (numeric) and nonverbal reasoning ability (puzzles, part-to-whole, and visual spatial manipulation of pictures). **The test results provide us with important information helpful in meeting your student's unique learning needs.** Your student will be taking the test September 23-25. The test will take place **first thing in the morning**, please be sure that your child is at school on time.
