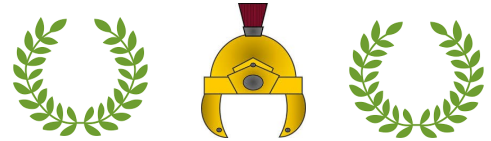
Students may bring their own cowboy hat to wear during their performance on assembly day. No boots or other western items please. This is a normal uniform day otherwise.
