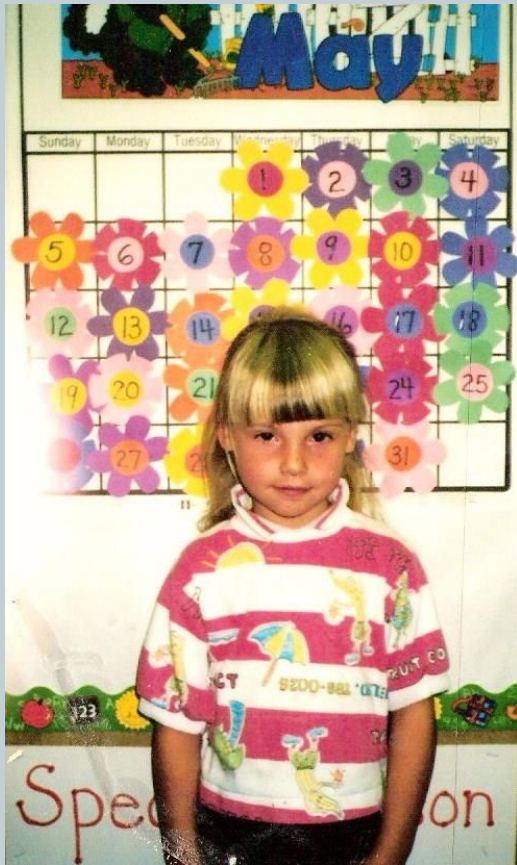

SILENT EPIDEMIC

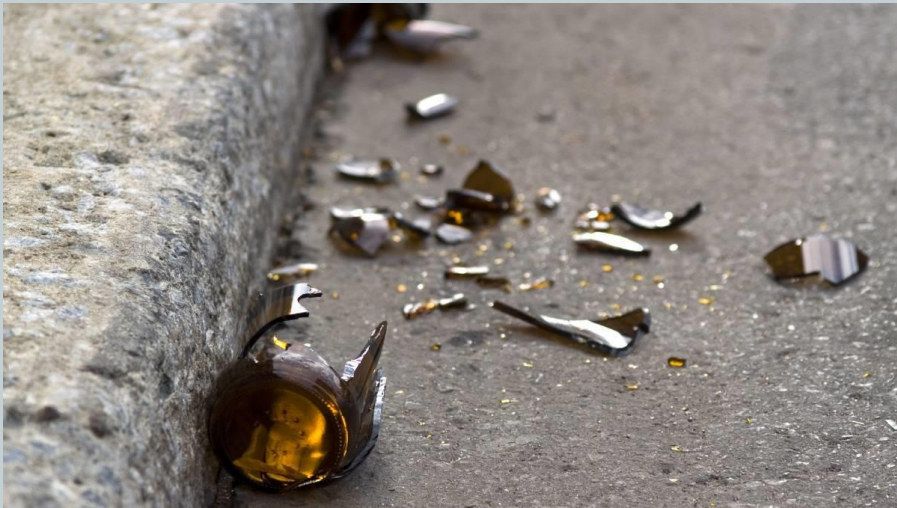


- Estimated 42 million survivors in America of child sexual abuse.
- 3 million of those are children.
- That could fill 46 national football stadiums.
- 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys are sexually abused by the age of 18.

Abuse began in 1996 and ended in 1998 when I finally told someone what was happening.



WARNING SIGNS OF ABUSE IN KIDS & TEENS

- **Nightmares**
- **Bed wetting**
- **Change in appetite**
- **Fear of certain people, places, activities**
- **Mood swings: Rage, Anger, Fear, anxiety, insecure or withdrawn**
- **Aggression**
- **Feeling shameful or guilty**
- **Change in Academics**
- **Avoiding someone they never had a problem with.**
- **Inappropriate clothing such as long sleeve shirts in warm weather.**
- **Acting out or disruptive behavior**
- **Coming to school too early or not wanting to go home.**
- **Eating Disorders**
- **Self Injury**
- **Drug and Alcohol Abuse**
- **Promiscuous activity**
- **Running away**
- **Suicidal**
- **Isolating oneself**
- **Resisting removing clothes when appropriate times (bedtime, bath time)**
- **Running away from home**
- **Suicidal thoughts**
- **Acting out sexually**
- **Exhibits adult sexual behaviors, knowledge, and language.**

IF CHILD DISCLOSES ABUSE TO YOU

- Do not act shocked
- Praise the child by telling them they did the right thing by telling
- Do not pry the child for information. Do not ask leading questions.
- Let child know they are safe now
- Make the child as comfortable as possible
- Reassure child this is not their fault
- Explain that the school has to notify the police
- Do NOT contact the parents if a child discloses abuse
- A parent may try and have their child recant the abuse they reported.
- Parent may take off with child and go into hiding
- Parent may confront abuser if known before police are involved
- Go directly to your principal and contact law enforcement.


LIFE AFTER ABUSE

- Experienced PTSD nightmares, flashbacks, panic attacks.
- Family divided and supporting my cousin.
- Self-harm and a suicide attempt.
- Confronting cousin in letter.
- 7 months of corresponding
- Finding my voice and letting go of shame.
- Forgiveness
- Turning diary into a book.
- Breaking silence about early abuse.

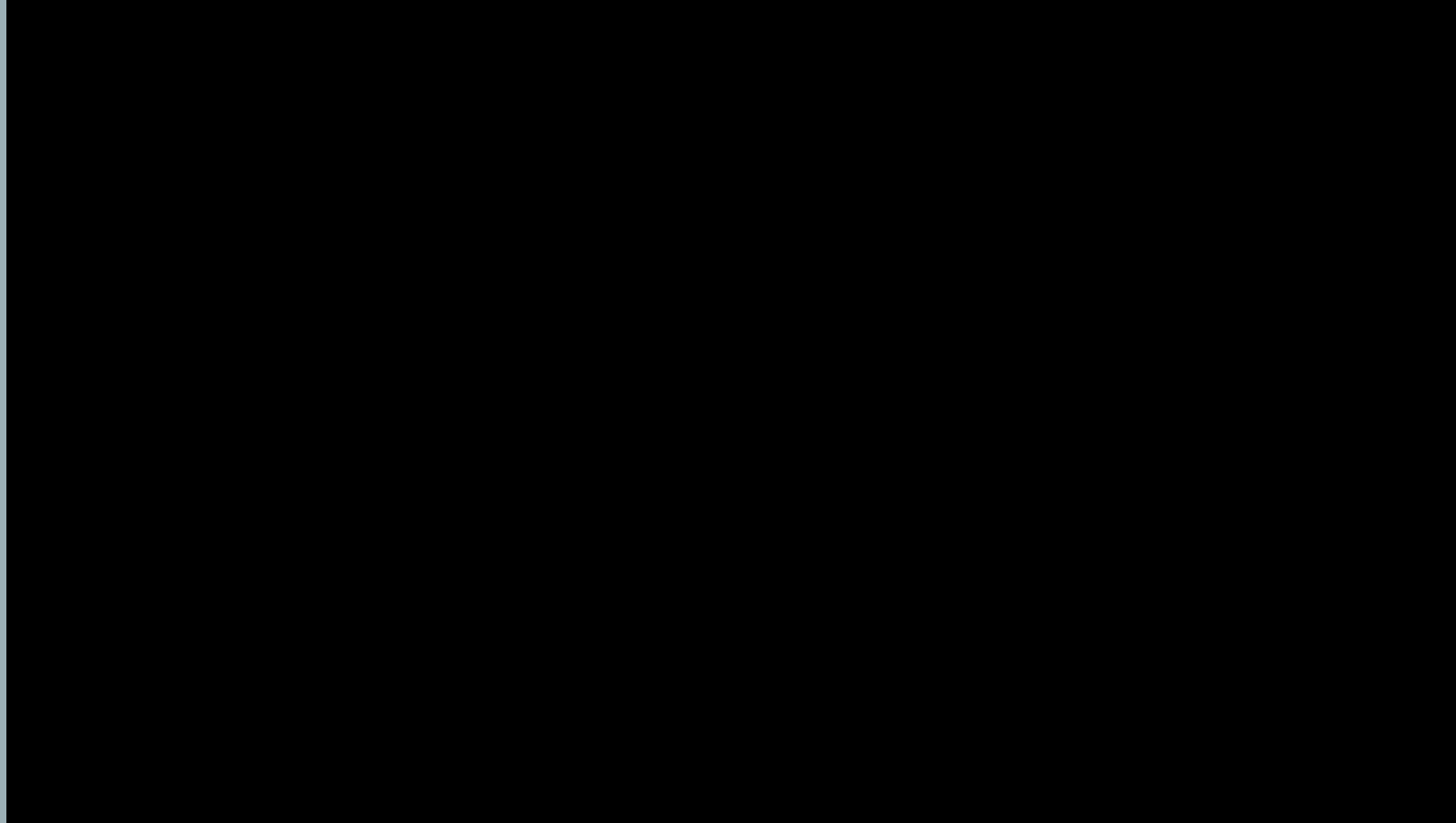

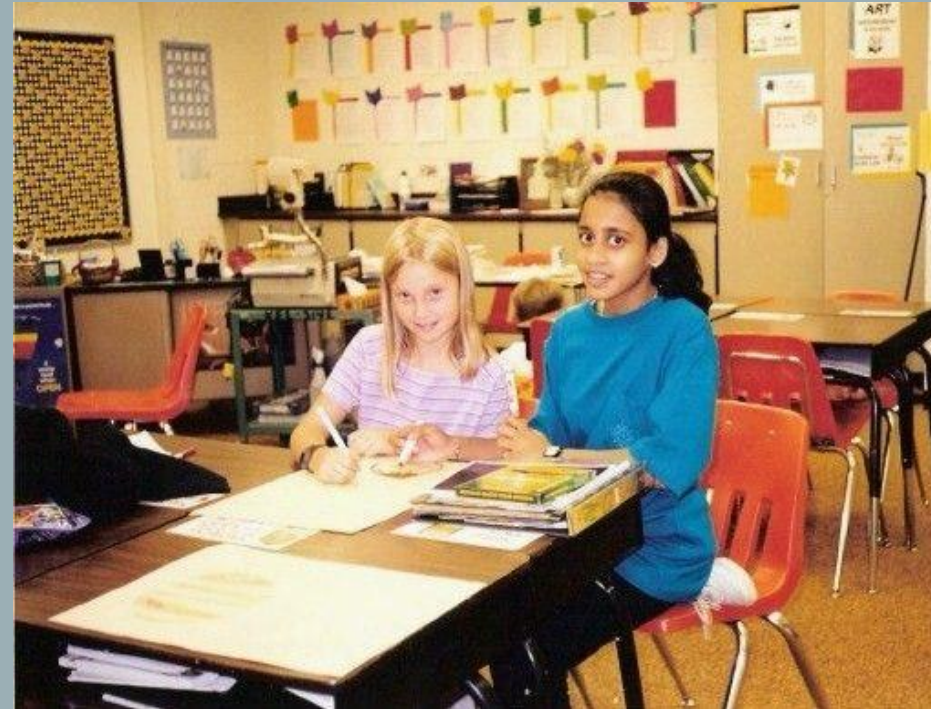

ILLINOIS TASK FORCE RECOMMENDATIONS

Erin's Law Task force passed in February 14, 2011. Can be found online.

First bill created a task force to study child sexual abuse.

Child sexual abuse prevention education should be taught in grades pre-K through 12. "Best Practices" should be included in this instruction.

Training for school administrators should be amended to include child sexual abuse as a selective strand under the Illinois Administrator Academy.

Child sexual abuse training should be provided as a certified professional development unit (CPDU) for certified non-administrative school personnel.

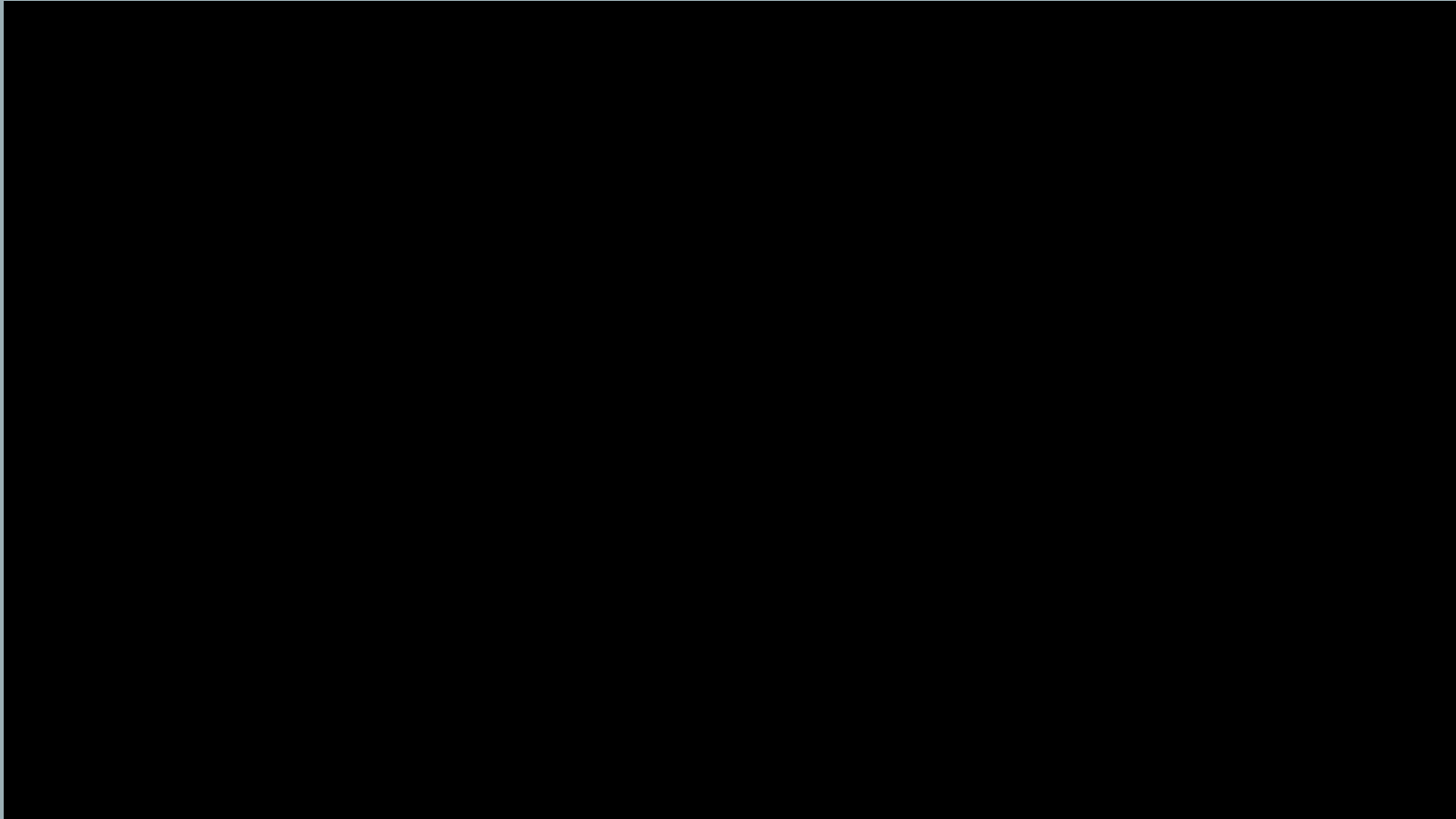
US Senator Gillibrand (NY) introduced federal bill.

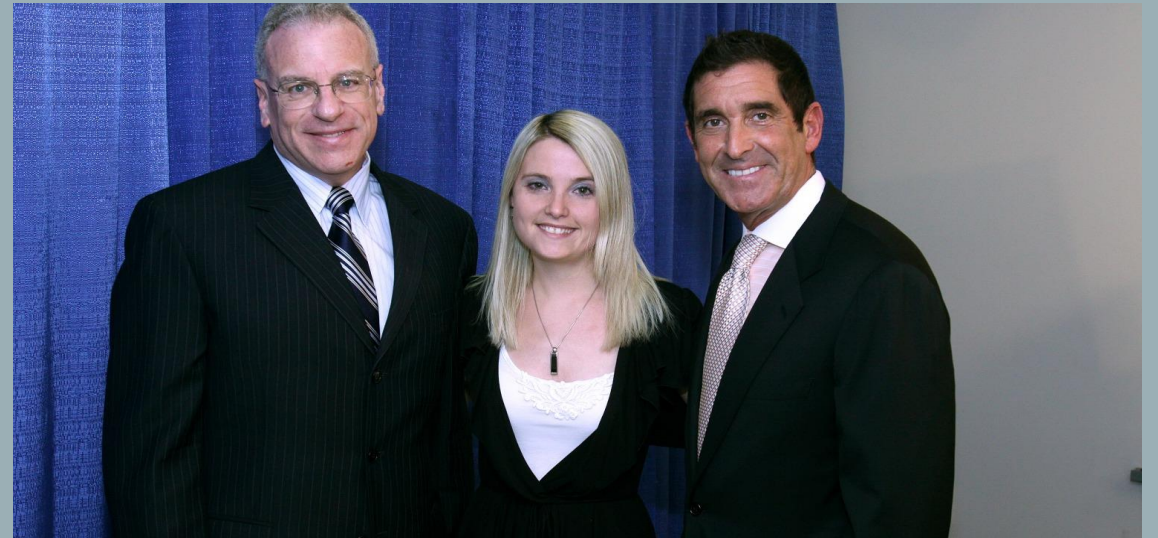

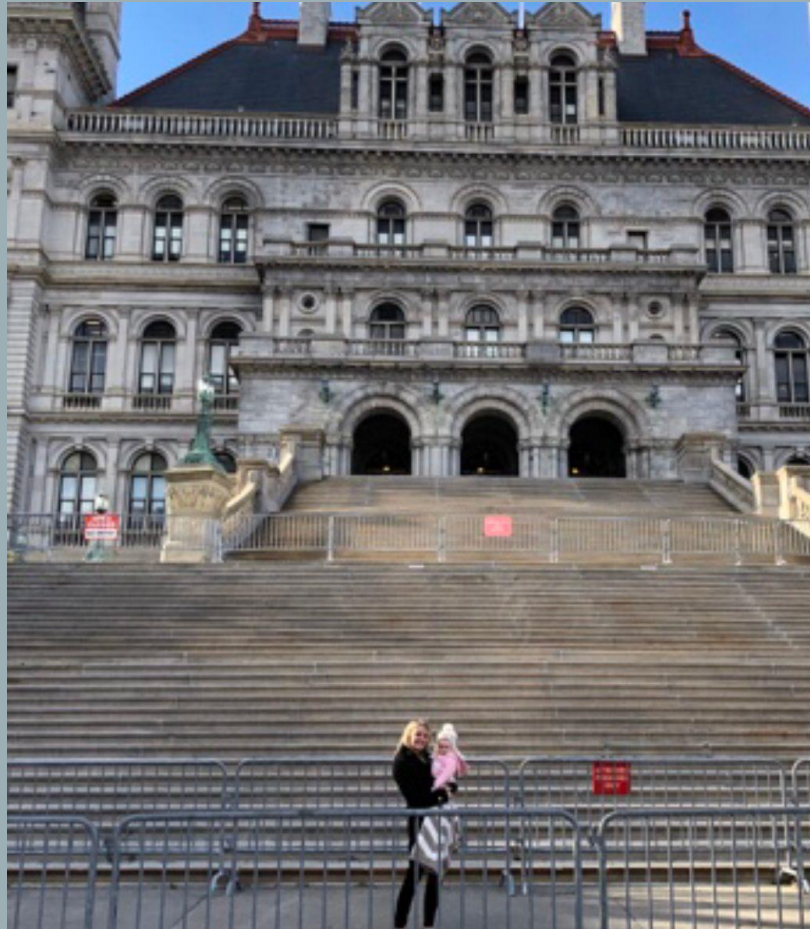
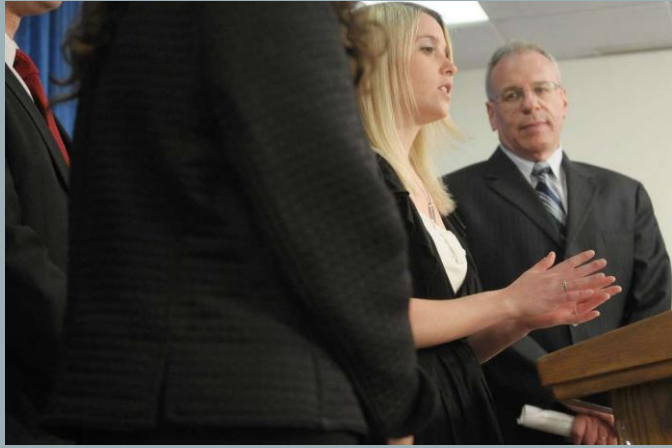

ERIN'S LAW DURING COVID

Child abuse and domestic violence is skyrocketing during COVID. School safest place for many kids.

Having social workers and school staff put together educational videos on personal body safety that can be shown at home.

Giving parents recommended list of books to read with children and tips on how to talk to kids about this.

Check in with families with higher risk of abuse and violence to be going on in the home.

If your school is going back in the Fall get Erin's Law lesson done right at the start of the year in the event that things go back to E-Learning.

KIDS IN THE KNOW

- **Kids in the Know (Canada) K-9th , longer: 6-8 lessons**
- Kids in the Know can be purchased for an individual grade level program or as kits with all supporting resources. In 2018 prices ranged from \$35 (CAD) for an individual grade program to \$310 (CAD) for a full kit from Kindergarten to Grade 10 with all supporting resources (lessons, activity sheets, posters, puppets, storybooks, etc.) Each lesson is designed to work in classroom setting – where time spent on the lesson and activities can be adjusted as needed. On average, a grade level will consist of 6-8 lessons, each with a delivery time of approximately 45 minutes. www.kidsintheknow.ca

PLAY IT SAFE

- Play it Safe! is an Evidence Informed, specialized, age appropriate child sexual abuse risk reduction program for children ages pre-school through 12th grade, as well as their parents, teachers and caregivers. Each grade level program includes an age appropriate video and script.
- Reduces risk by teaching children to identify abusive behavior, and provides tools children need to be safe including specific, age appropriate actions to take in threatening situations.
- Each grade level program can be purchased as a hard copy with DVD and Script or online only. The cost for Pre-K through 2nd grade hard copies, which also includes online streaming for a year, cost \$299 each. They come with a set of Joe and Suzy dolls and 25 coloring books in either English or Spanish. Online cost for these grade levels is \$199
- The total hard copy cost for all 14 programs is \$3,186 plus shipping. For online purchases only,

BE SAFE AT LAST

- Safe@Last is a sequential personal safety curriculum that empowers students in kindergarten through sixth grade by providing critical skills and tools to stay safe and avoid dangerous situations. Each lesson builds on and reinforces the skills learned in previous sessions with opportunities for students to practice each learned skill. The program includes age-appropriate learning techniques such as role-playing, music, games, stories, and an interactive online workbook to enhance the learning process for each individual student.

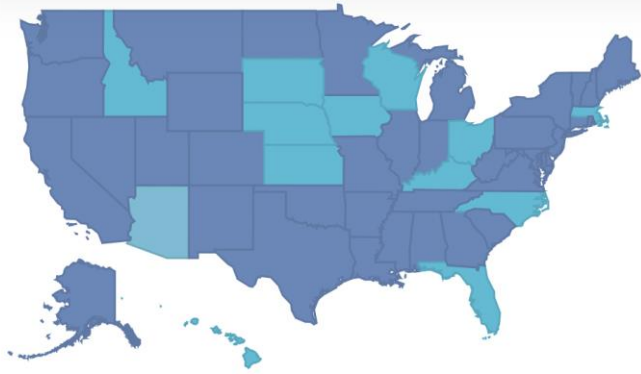
