Bus Monitor (Freelance)

We are looking for freelancers who would like to accompany our school bus as a supervisor on days when school is in session in the afternoon from 3 pm from ISH to the final stop (depending on the respective bus: Finkenau, Streekbrücke or Am Kaiserkai at about 3:45 pm)

Responsibilities:

- Monitor student behavior during afternoon bus trips to ensure the health and safety of the students
- Ensure students are following the bus rules including:
 - a. No eating of food,
 - b. Headphones are required when using a mobile device,
 - c. No walking or standing in the aisles,
 - d. No loud talking or shouting,
 - e. Not distracting the driver,
 - f. No use of glass bottles
- Address student misbehavior when needed by reminding the student of the expectation
- Report repeated student misbehavior in writing to the respective division assistant principals, sharing the names and behavior violation summary
- Support students to be following the mission, vision and core values of ISH

What we expect:

- Good communication skills in English
- Commitment to child safety and protection
- Experience in dealing with young people is an advantage
- Valid work permit for freelance work in Germany (if applicable)
- Police clearance certificate without entries (Erweitertes Führungszeugnis)
- Proof of sufficient vaccination protection against measles or existing immunity

Important to know:

- Starting date is flexible
- It is possible to apply for Monday to Friday or for individual days of the week,
- Compensation will be EUR 50 per day per trip and school will pay for monthly HVV travel ticket (currently Deutschlandticket)
