If a student reaches out for assistance they should be given priority over completing a professional development session/assignment.

Student Expectations:

- Login and Participation: Students should log into their courses and use Google Meet to participate in live streaming sessions daily.
- Independent Navigation: Students are expected to access Canvas using their school-issued email to navigate courses, Google Meet, email, and drive independently.
- Family Involvement: Families are encouraged to regularly check the Canvas courses set up by teachers. With guidance from educators, families can help students establish a daily schedule to complete assigned activities effectively.
- Engagement in Learning Activities: Students should actively participate in synchronous sessions via Google Meet and also complete the asynchronous activities provided in their Canvas classrooms. We recognize that

not all students may be able to engage in synchronous activities; flexibility in participation is provided to accommodate various student needs.

Instruction:

- **Specials Classes (Gym, Music, etc.)**: Special classes will operate on an asynchronous basis, following the established rotation days according to the rotation calendar. This scheduling ensures that students receive varied instructional content throughout the term.
- **Live Sessions**: Google Meet Live sessions will be scheduled through a recurring link. Students will be able to join the session only after the teacher has initiated it. It is the instructor's responsibility to ensure all students have exited the session before it concludes.
