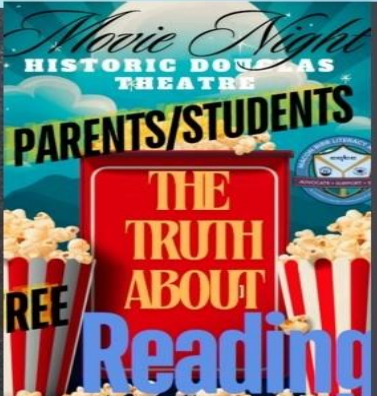
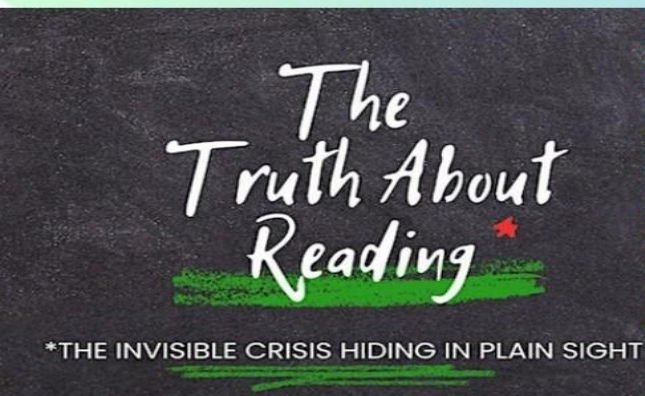
NEIGHBORHOOD CLEANUP & COMMUNITY GARDEN DAY

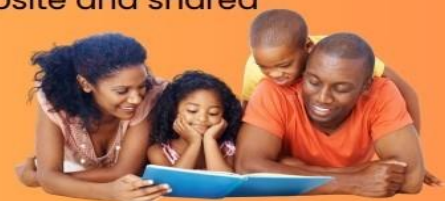
