Call to Order

Attorney's Business

Mr. Moyle reported the matter related to the Union recertification process was currently before the Public Employees Relation Commission.

Mr. Moyle reported he had assisted the school with disciplinary matters, including a recommendation for expulsion. He indicated a Hearing Officer would need to be appointed during the action portion of the meeting.

Director's Business

Dr. Chambers reported the school's facilities did not sustain any damage during the recent storm, and a full shelter activation was not needed. She indicated staff was still assessing the tornados' impact on school faculty, staff and students.

Other Business

Dr. Davis asked if the board was prepared to proceed with the Director's evaluation. Mr. Moyle indicated the Chair had opted to delay it until the conclusion of an ongoing audit, and the receipt of student achievement data.
