Students can retake class assessments once if they earned less than a 75%.

Weighted GPA

Calculate the weighted factor by adding 1.0 for each Honors level course and 1.5 for each Advanced Placement level credit (contingent upon a student taking the Advanced Placement exam).

Class Rank

Rank in class is computed at the end of the junior and senior year. Class rank is based upon the weighted cumulative grade point average from courses taken in grades 9 through 12.
