Seventy-four percent of Howard School graduates over the past five years have been eligible to receive the Hope Scholarship, Georgia's merit based scholarship for students who achieve a 3.0 GPA and take at least four courses of rigor. In 2024, 89% were eligible.

Since its founding in 1950, The Howard School has educated students ages five through 12th grade who have diagnosed language-based learning differences such as dyslexia, dyscalculia, dysgraphia, and expressive/receptive language delays.

Located in the heart of the City of Atlanta, Howard is a diverse community of approximately 300 Learners.

CURRICULUM

High School students study a **college preparatory curriculum** that enables them to learn confidently and become self-advocates for their own learning. With small class sizes, students can be **highly interactive with teachers** and benefit from **Assistive Technology support**.

Our school year is divided into two 18-week semesters, separated by a mini-mester in early January where students can explore a variety of elective courses.

GRADING

Howard reports GPA on a standard 4.0 scale **but neither ranks students nor weighs courses**.

CREDITS TO GRADUATE

To graduate, students must accrue a total of 23 Carnegie units at follows:

- + 4 credits – English
- + 1 credit – Health/Physical Education
- + 4 credits – Mathematics
- + 2 credits – Foreign Language (of the same language)
- + 3 credits – Social Studies (Including Government and Economics & Personal Finance)
- + 4 credits – Sciences
- + 5 credits – Electives
