

# Red Winged Blackbird By Catherine Sause

The Red Winged Blackbird (also known as Agelaius Phoeniceus) is a North American bird seen from Alaska to Canada, Mexico and Central America. They can be found in a variety of habitats, such as wetlands, marshes, meadows, and fields. They are migratory, which means they move north when the temperatures rise, and south when they drop. It is a medium sized songbird, but the males of the species are a bit larger than the females. The males have distinctive glossy black feathers and bright red and yellow patches on the wings, which they mostly display during territorial battles. The females are brown and black with streaked underparts. Both male and female birds have sharp, pointed beaks and long, slender tails.



The red-winged blackbird is also omnivorous, meaning they eat a wide variety of plant and animal foods, such as insects, seeds, and fruits. These birds are known to feed in flocks, especially during the non-breeding season. They are socially monogamous, and usually breed in loose flocks. The males defend their territory and commonly mate with multiple females. The females build cup-shaped nests, usually near water, and lay 3-4 eggs per clutch.

These songbirds are also known for their unique calls, which have a great variety. The male's song is a distinctive, high-pitched trill that is often heard during the breeding season. Ultimately, this songbird is a common and unique bird species, known for its striking plumage and unique vocalizations.

# ALS Rides for Life! By Madelyn Halter



# Song Review: "Without You" By Angelina Altamirano

Today I am going to be reviewing Kard's newest comeback single. "Without You" is their latest digital single after 9 months since their last comeback with their mini album *RE*:. "But who is Kard?" you may be asking. Well, just sit back as I tell you who they are and review their song.

Kard is a co-ed (mixed gender) K-pop group formed by DSP Media, consisting of four members: J.Seph - the main rapper and sub vocalist, BM - the lead dancer, main rapper and sub vocalist, Somin - the main vocalist and visual and last but certainly not least, Jiwoo - the main dancer, lead vocalist, sub rapper and maknae (youngest member). They also have this concept within the group where each member represents a different card. J.Seph represents the ace, BM represents the king, Somin is the black joker and Jiwoo is the color joker. They released three songs pre-debut including "Oh Nana", "Don't Recall" and "Rumor" (which are all bops) and debuted officially on July 19, 2017, with their album *Hola Hola*.

Now let's review "Without You".

Right off the bat, the song is very upbeat and bright, incorporating Latin and tropical music styles. Towards the end, the song shifts to a soft and subtle melody and then changes back to the original melody of the song. I really like the direction of the production of the song, and I think that the producers did an amazing job putting the song together. The vocals were okay in my opinion and so was the rap. I will say this though - the chorus and post-chorus is very addicting. BM's verse is amazing. His flow and lyricism are impeccable. The only thing that I had a problem with was line distribution because throughout the whole song I feel like most of the lines were taken by mainly

Somin, meanwhile BM and J.Seph were kind of invisible throughout the track.

I really liked the music video. I liked the whole vibe and aesthetic of it because the set that they used really pulled it all together since it had these tropical looking flowers on it, and they also had CGI butterflies in some of the scenes with Somin. Plus, I absolutely loved Somin's hair and makeup. What I didn't like were the outfits since some of the members had outfits that really clashed with the others.

# Mega Man 11 By Wyatt Casdia

Mega Man 11 is a platformer/shooter game that requires split second reactions and planning to advance throughout the multiple stages throughout the game. You play as Mega Man, a robot created by Dr. Light to protect the people of the year 20XX from the evil Dr. Wily who has captured Dr. Light's 8 robot masters (Block Man, Acid Man, Blast Man, Fuse Man, Bounce Man, Torch Man, Impact Man, and Tundra Man). Dr. Wily changes their programming and installs the double gear system which can make a robot faster or stronger but only for a short time because the robot will overheat when used for too long.

After Dr. Wily leaves, Dr. Light gives Mega Man the double gear system and then he sets out on his journey to beat Dr. Wily and save the robot masters. In order to beat a robot master, you must beat its stage which is its level. After you beat a robot master, you get its power known as an ability which can only be used a certain number of times unless you collect weapon energy which increases your weapon gauge for that ability. When you get hit, your energy gauge goes down. If it gets low enough, you can activate double gear which gives you both abilities from the double gear. When your energy gauge reaches zero, you die. The only things that can insta kill you are spikes and falling off the level.

People play Mega Man 11 because it is hard but when beaten is very rewarding and because the music is top of the line. If you are new to the game, you can choose Newcomer Difficulty which gives you infinite lives and unlimited spike boots and beat calls. Spike boots and beat calls are items purchased in the reactor room where you can spend screws to fabricate items. Items included are E tanks which heals you to full energy, W tanks which fills up your weapon gauge and 1-ups which gives you an extra try in levels. There are also beat calls which will catch you if you fall off the level, spike boots which saves you from an instant death by spikes one time and more. You can also buy permanent upgrades from the reactor which will help you in battle.

# A Definitive Ranking of April K-pop Releases By Jasmin Law

April 2023 had some incredibly interesting releases in K-pop. From comebacks to collaborations to even advertisements. Here is my personal rating of a few of April's K-pop singles and albums.

#### - "Zero" - NewJeans (7.4/10)

Coca-Cola Korea recently partnered with Ador girl group NewJeans which included a paid promotional music video, "Zero". On first listen, I didn't like the song as much as other Bunnies (NewJeans fandom name) had enjoyed it. Although, as I heard the song more often, it started to grow on me a bit. "Zero" is catchy for an ad, but even though it's an ad, I thought the chorus promotion came off a bit too strong. NewJeans went from singing about a simple crush to calling Coca-Cola tasty too fast and it messed with my head. "Zero" is one of my lesser liked NewJeans song but it's just an ad and I know that NewJeans will put out a banger for their official comeback in July.

## - *Lovestruck* - Kep1er (8.6/10)

Kepler (Kepler), a girl group formed from the show *Girls Planet 999*, released their 4<sup>th</sup> mini album, *Lovestruck*, on April 10<sup>th</sup> with the title track, "Giddy". The lead song is cute and fits Kepler's whole aesthetic, but I don't think it should have been the title track. Not only is "LVLY" my favorite B-side but it is also the best B-side, and that's why I believe they should've made "LVLY" the title track. As for the other B-sides, they were okay but still likable, especially "Why". The only recommendations I have are "Giddy" and "LVLY".

### - *I've Ive* - IVE (8.8/10)

I realize that I talk badly about title tracks a lot, but "I Am" really is a great title track. It also reminds me of those early 2010s girl power songs, if that makes sense. "Heroine" and "Hypnosis" simply seemed better than "I Am" in my opinion. They were both the best B-sides and in my top 3 tracks, that is how good they were. I've Ive's recommendations are "Cherish", "Heroine" and "Hypnosis", but "I Am" isn't a bad track.

### - Perfume - NCT DoJaeJung (9.3/10)

NCT DoJaeJung is the new NCT unit consisting of main vocalists, Doyoung, Jaehyun, and Jungwoo. I have not stopped repeating "Perfume" since it came out. It is genuinely the perfect title track for the album. Yes, the B-sides are good and catchy, but they can't out beat "Perfume". From the riffs to the harmonization, "Perfume" is perfect, and I wouldn't ask for anything more or less. However, "Kiss" is one of the best B-side tracks, and "Strawberry Sunday" has admirable vocals with the down low early 2010s love song sound. But out of all the B-sides, "Can We Go Back" is my favorite while "Perfume" is, of course, my all-time favorite off the album. From *Perfume*, I'd recommend "Perfume", "Strawberry Sunday", and "Can We Go Back".

### - Deadlock - Xdinary Heroes (9.5/10)

Xdinary Heroes title tracks keep progressively getting crazier and crazier, and that includes "Freakin' Bad", but that isn't a bad thing. It is such a powerful title track, especially when things peak at the bridge. They went insane with this album from the fan chant for "Freakin' Bad" to O.de's rap in "Bicycle" to all the instrumental solos, and of course let's not forget all the mood changes. Deadlock starts out hype, sad for "Good enough", immediately switches to an upbeat rock feel for "Man in the Box", and for the last song on the album, "Dear H.", they go back to that sad feeling. Speaking of "Good Enough", I could go on about this song, but unfortunately, I don't have time. "Good Enough" is their first all English song and it's vocal heavy with no raps – aka a ballad. The song is sad, more so when you know the meaning behind it, and I could cry to it, but it's

also my favorite off Deadlock. In conclusion, I need 3-5 business days to process the whiplash I got from this masterpiece, and I recommend "Freakin' Bad", "Good Enough" and "Man in the Box".

#### - D-Day - Agust D (9.6/10)

Agust D, also known as Suga of BTS, put out the 3<sup>rd</sup> album to his 'Agust D trilogy', titled *D-Day*. Starting this off with I am an Agust D fan, like barely seconds into "D-Day" and title track, "Haegeum" and they were put into my favorite playlist. His vocals are nice, especially in "SDL" and "People pt. 2", considering he's mostly a rapper and some rappers don't have good vocals. In "People pt. 2", a calmer song compared to the rest, they gave most of the vocals and riffs to the feature IU, which makes sense seeing how IU is more of a vocalist and Agust D is more of a rapper. It doesn't exactly matter though because I loved them harmonizing and Agust D's heavenly vocals. D-Day's hip-hop and R&B sound fits the whole Agust D image, but he's always worked with that genre. Honestly, I can't wait to see what he creates next, whether it's with BTS or solo because he is



such an amazing artist. The whole story behind D-Day is special and sad, so I'd recommend watching *Suga: Road to D-Day* on Disney+ and listening to "Haegeum", "HUH", and "People pt. 2".

And on that note, comes the end of my little review. I hope this helped you find a new song or album to listen to. My overall recommendation for this month is "D-Day" from Agust D because it's special and sounds amazing.

The show *RuPaul's Drag Race* is one of the most important shows in the LGBTQIA+ community, winning 12 Emmy awards and having very diverse casts. The show has queens of different racial backgrounds and gender identities. Some of them are transgender or even straight as we saw in season 14 with Maddy Morphosis. The *Drag Race* franchise has also expanded with franchises in the UK, Canada, Thailand, Spain, and France just to name a few.

Last year, MTV announced season 15 of RuPaul's Drag Race. In the promo, we were introduced to 16 queens competing for the grand prize of \$200,000 which is the largest prize in the show's history. Season 15 was the first season of the show to ever air on MTV with the previous seasons airing on VH1 and Logo. We also got to see performances from our Top 4 queens, with Anetra performing "Lotus", Sasha Colby performing "Goddess", Luxx Noir London

I also enjoyed Orville Peck, Leland and the season 15 cast, who sang the song "Built on Drag" from the *Wigloose* musical.

We got to the final stretch when RuPaul declared that Anetra and Sasha Colby made it to the finals and Luxx Noir London and Mistress Isabelle Brooks were eliminated.

Sasha and Anetra had to Lip Sync for The Crown. It was then declared that the winner of *RuPaul's Drag Race* season 15 was Sasha Colby! In her winning speech, Sasha said, "This goes to every trans person, past, present, and future because we are not going anywhere." Sasha Colby is the fifth transgender winner of *RuPaul's Drag Race* franchise. The first winner was Kylie Sonique Love on *RuPaul's Drag Race All Stars* season 6.

Welcome back to another set of Ariana Grande updates. Today, I will be talking about new Ariana Grande info. So let's get started!


#### r.e.m. beauty

- ¾ cup sugar
- 1 large egg, room temp
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 cup chocolate chips



#### **Instructions:**

- Preheat the oven to 350F. Spray a 9x5 inch loaf pan with cooking spray. Set aside.
- In a bowl, mix together the flour, cocoa powder, baking soda and salt. Set aside.
- In a bowl mash banana with a fork. Stir in melted butter and coconut oil and mix until combined. Add sugar, egg, and vanilla until smooth.
- Combine dry ingredients into wet. Add chocolate chips leaving some to pour on top.
- Pour into loaf pan. Bake for 55-60 minutes.
- Cool for 15 minutes and enjoy!

**Thoughts:** I thought this was really good, better than normal banana bread! My parents also really liked it. NOTE: I used an 8x8 inch square glass baking dish. It worked fine for me. You can do that if you don't have a loaf pan.






