Gingerbread House Decorating Contest







The Multiverse Saga By Daniel Varley

During Comic-Con in San Diego, back in July of this year, one of the biggest announcements in Marvel history was made. In Hall H, Marvel Studios executive Kevin Feige announced Phases 5 and 6 of the Marvel Cinematic Universe. Kicking off Phase 5 will be Ant-Man and the Wasp: *Ouantumania*, which hits theaters on February 17, 2023. Other installments in Phase 5 include Guardians of the Galaxy Volume 3, Secret Invasion and more that were previously revealed. The new announcements for Phase 5 include an 18-episode Disney+ series called Daredevil: Born Again. It stars Charlie Cox returning as Matt Murdock/Daredevil and Vincent D'Onofrio returning as Wilson Fisk, better known as the Kingpin.

There were two other movie announcements. *Captain America: New World Order* will have Anthony Mackie playing the new Captain America. He first debuted as the Falcon in 2014's *Captain America: The Winter Soldier*. The main antagonist of the film will be Samuel Sterns, who was last seen in 2008's *The Incredible Hulk*. Tim Blake Nelson has been confirmed to reprise his role as Sterns and Harrison Ford has been confirmed in the role of Thaddeus "Thunderbolt" Ross. Ross is speculated to become the Red Hulk in this movie. Speaking of Thunderbolt Ross, *Thunderbolts*, a movie about a team of antiheroes that will feature Ross will hit theaters in 2024 alongside *Captain America: New World Order*.

The big news came when Phase 6 was presented! The previously announced *Fantastic Four* was confirmed to be released in early 2025. Toward the end of Phase 6, *Avengers: The Kang Dynasty* and *Avengers: Secret Wars* will be released. These two films will complete Phase 6 and The Multiverse Saga. The antagonist of *Avengers: The Kang Dynasty* will be Kang the Conqueror, played by Jonathan Majors. Before that, Kang will appear in *Ant-Man and the Wasp: Quantumania*, as well as season 2 of *Loki*. In September, Ryan Reynolds announced the release of *Deadpool 3*, which will now take place in the Marvel Cinematic Universe. This will feature Reynolds as Deadpool as well as Hugh Jackman, who returns to play Wolverine one last time.

Other films in Phase 6 are unknown but there is speculation that includes sequels to *Shang-Chi and the Legend of the Ten Rings, Eternals,* a third *Doctor Strange* movie, and a fifth *Thor* film. Other rumored projects include a *Wonder-Man* Disney+ series, a project on Nova, a movie about Hercules, and even a possible Ghost Rider project.

Now, some of you might be asking how Spider-Man fits into all of this, but I do have an answer. A fourth Spider-Man film is confirmed to be in the works and is speculated to deal with the aftermath of *Daredevil: Born Again*. We're still unsure about how everything will tie into the Multiverse, but I can say this next chapter of the Marvel Cinematic Universe will be wild.

Sasaeng: Inside the Rabbit Hole By Angelina Altamirano



I'm sure many of you have heard of the industry powerhouse that is K-pop. From the colorful performances to appearances on TV shows like Cartoon Network's *We Bare Bears* and Nickelodeon's reboot of *All That*, K-pop has become a cultural phenomenon. Bands are gaining many views of their videos. For example, BTS had 101 million views in the first 24 hours of release. These views are, of course, achieved by the fans.

But what is going on within the fandom? Is there a dark side? The sad truth is that there is a dark side. The K-pop fandom has different levels of fans: the normal fans, the overly obsessed fans and then there is another level, more darker and demented called $\lambda \rightarrow \forall$ (sasaeng). But, what is sasaeng?

A sasaeng fan is an overly obsessed K-pop fan that will go to extreme lengths to prove their love to the band or performers they absolutely idolize. The term sasaeng comes from these two Korean words: $^{+}$ (Sa), private and $^{+}$ (Saeng), life. Sasaengs will invade their idols' privacy just to prove their love for them, as shown in Super M's episode of *All That*, where three fans go into the band's dressing room and take their personal belongings. But Nickelodeon almost romanticizes this. After Super M confronts their fans about going into their dressing room, one of the fans asks if they can do a performance for her, to which they reply "Sure!" P.S.: If you do this in real life, they'll most likely call security!!! This first situation has just gotten some traction now, but the stalking has been going on for at least three years. One sasaeng has been stalking a member of the K-pop band, Twice. The member being stalked is Nayeon. The fan has been going out of their way to prove to Nayeon that he absolutely adores her. In 2019, he started making numerous YouTube videos expressing his love for her. He went to her favorite places in Korea including restaurants and stores, asking employees for Nayeon's phone number or one of her family member's numbers so that he could contact her.

It got more intense when the fan found out Twice's flight information and snuck on to the plane to give her a letter. He was promptly wrestled down by bodyguards and managers and was thrown off the plane. The fan also leaked another member's phone number in order to ask for Nayeon's number. Twice's record label, JYP Entertainment, put out a statement saying, "We have confirmed the circumstances in which Twice member Chaeyoung's personal information has been leaked online and distributed without permission." They said that they were going to take legal action.

In 2020, Nayeon filed a restraining order against the fan in order to protect herself and her bandmates. After that, the fan apparently found another member's phone number and called her. Fans of the band have trended the hashtag #SaveNayeon, to give her support and well wishes during this scary time.

Sasaengs aren't just stalkers. Well, actually, a majority of them are stalkers. One fan installed security cameras outside of an idols' home to see where they were going in order to follow them around. Another tried to take a member of Girls' Generation off stage. One of the band members saw this and quickly saved her. The man was escorted off stage by security shortly after.

Things can get dark very quickly. Some fans have gone as far as doing bodily harm. One fan squirted their favorite idol in the eye with a water gun. This

may seem harmless, right? I mean, it's just a water gun and it was probably filled with water, right? No. The water gun was filled with a mixture of soy sauce and vinegar. The performer was temporarily blinded and had cornea damage because of this.

Then there is the most notable instance which is very well-known in the K-pop world when talking about sasaengs. It was one of the first stories I thought about when writing this article. For those who don't know this story, I will tell you.

In 2006, a sasaeng fan gave Yunho of TVXQ a glass of orange juice. This fan was apparently a Yunho anti-fan. According to Yunho, he thought the "fan" was a staff member, so he didn't really think anything of it and drank it. You probably wouldn't have thought anything of it either until you found out that the "orange juice" was laced with super glue.

Yes, you heard me correctly. Super glue.

After he drank the "orange juice", he started to vomit and was hospitalized immediately. He could have died from this. The sasaeng turned themselves in and told the police that it was just a prank.

An article from Soompi.com, retelling the incident stated "In a letter that accompanied the glass of juice, Go wrote, 'Be careful what you say, you won't last long. Do you have any idea how many people change the channel as soon as TVXQ comes on?' along with other, similar sentiments." This experience caused Yunho to develop a panic disorder and he drank ten cups of orange juice to get over it. "I felt like I was arrogant. I thought I overcame the trauma..." he said in an interview back in 2019.

Now what have we learned? It is ok to love a celebrity. It's completely fine to talk about them 24/7, stream your favorite songs by them or watch every single movie or show they are in. But there is a fine line between expressing your love and

admiration for an artist and just completely invading their personal space, taking their belongings, or expressing acts of violence.

I really like K-pop too. I love the fandom and the music. Everything about it is great but I wouldn't invade someone's privacy. If you love an artist or band or any celebrity, great! Don't let that obsession get out of hand. Make your obsession healthy. Just don't get put in jail.



An overview of 3 smash hit Roblox games: *Piggy, Doors,* and *Rainbow Friends* By Griffin Byrne

Roblox is one of the most frequently used platforms of all time, where creators can make their own games and upload them. Some of the most successful games are *Piggy*, *Doors*, and *Rainbow Friends*. Each game is extremely well thought out and developed.

Piggy is a game with a sort of childish start. It takes place in the Peppa Pig universe, about 5 years after the show. You are the main character of the story, playing a police officer and are sent to investigate a missing persons case for Georgie Pig (the names were changed due to copyright). You find a monster pig with a baseball bat who chases you around while you find color coded keys to unlock doors. When you escape, it is revealed to be some sort of zombie apocalypse. There are 24 maps with bonuses in between. The storyline is very good and treasured by most. If you are hit by a monster's weapon, you become one of them. Can you beat the game and discover the mysterious origins of the apocalypse?

Roblox Doors is another game more focused on horror elements. There are 100 doors which you can walk through or unlock with keys and puzzles if needed. There are 2 chase sequences but random scares throughout. Another scary sequence comes at door 50. A monster who bears close resemblance to the Demogorgon from *Stranger Things* will chase you around a library. The rooms are all random except for a few. It is one of the most popular and enjoyed games on the platform.

For the third and final game, we have *Rainbow Friends*. It starts with a group of students on a bus heading to a theme park called Odd World. There is a sign with an arrow leading to it, but a mysterious shadow arm switches the direction, leading the bus to crash and the students to be kidnapped. You awake in an old abandoned indoor theme park where multiple-colored monsters such as Blue, Green, and Orange reside. The shadow man tells you that his blocks fell over and that you must find and place them back.

On the first night, the monster Blue comes out and reveals that if you get to him first, he will knock

you out and the shadow man will take you away. More monsters come out every time for 5 nights until a final night where Blue chases you through a vent system until you escape the theme park. You can find the story on the map and challenges where lots of things are revealed.

All three of these amazing games are very fun to play. I highly suggest downloading *Roblox* and playing these spectacular three games.

K-pop: A Look Through History By Jasmin Law

What do people think of when they talk about of K-pop? They probably think of BTS (Bangtan Boys; we'll get into them later) and their crazy fans -- they're called ARMY, by the way. Well, I think of something different. I think of a community, a culture, and how it came to be. If you don't want a little history lesson, then leave now.

Back in the 1960s, around the Korean War, rock bands like Add4 and the Key Boys played in bars and clubs in Seoul, South Korea. Some bars were near military bases where soldiers, Korean and American alike, would come and listen to their music. But soon, things got complicated as Korea fell under a dictatorship and the government banned Korean rock music and arrested musicians but, we can skip over all that.

Fast forward to the 90s when an iconic group called Seo Taiji & Boys debuted. With influences from Western hip-hop, R&B, and Korean ballads, this group created the foundation for what we now know as modern K-pop, your average BTS and BLACKPINK. As Seo Taiji & Boys began to retire, SM Entertainment debuted one of the first K-pop boy groups in 1996, H.O.T. (High-five Of Teenagers), inspired by American boy groups and Japanese idols. A year later, in 1997, SM Entertainment debuted one of the first K-pop girl groups, S.E.S. (Sea, Eugene, Shoo). H.O.T. and S.E.S., among other K-pop groups, make up the first generation of K-pop. Generation 1.5 was full of "experimental" groups like Shinhwa, g.o.d. and BoA.

BoA is a female soloist who was the first K-pop artist to reach number one on the Japanese Oricon music charts in August of 2000. She represented the birth of K-pop for international audiences and Hallyu, a wave where Korean influences and cultural markets reached outside Korea. However, Wonder Girls was how K-pop entered the U.S. market.

K-pop was still new when YouTube launched. So, what event sparked K-pop fans throughout the web? Well, of course, that would be thanks to Psy's "Gangnam Style." The song was the first YouTube video to hit one billion views, and people started getting into K-pop. Before that, another piece contributed a lot to Hallyu, and that song was "Sorry Sorry" by Super Junior. The choreography and music video for this song taught the K-pop entertainment industry that they could remain true to themselves and their culture and still gain mass popularity.

After more attempts at breaking into the Englishlanguage market, generation 3 global superstars BTS debuted in 2013. They would become what I know as one of the top K-pop boy groups in the world. Well, they did meet U.S. President Joe Biden, so I think it's safe to say they're on top.

As of October 2022, BTS will begin their mandatory military service in South Korea, starting with Jin. All members will reunite in 2025, and hopefully, their service release won't be delayed like some people (ahem, Taemin).

For the sake of everyone still reading, I won't go on about all the major K-pop groups and how they're doing. I will say, however, to stream Stray Kids' album *Maxident*. If you like rap or hip-hop, you'll definitely enjoy the music made by our generation 4 kings, Stray Kids.

Thank you for listening to my slightly long Ted Talk, and I'll see you in 2025 when BTS comes back from their military service.

Recipe: Spoonful of Sugar Cake Pops

Ingredients

- 1 box of cake mix with required ingredients as per box
- 1 tub of vanilla frosting
- White candy melts
- White sugar crystals
- Plastic Spoons
- Wax paper

Directions

1. Mix the cake according to the instructions on the box.

2. Bake the cake by following the instructions on the box. Make sure the cake is completely cooled off before you move on to the next step.

3. Once the cake is cooled, in a large bowl, crumble the cake into small pieces.

4. After crumbling the cake, now you can add the frosting. It's recommended that you use creamy buttercream frosting. Mix the frosting and the cake crumbles together thoroughly.

5. Lay a piece of wax paper on a cookie sheet. Roll small cake balls and place them on your sheet. These cake pops are going to have to be a smaller pop in order to fit into your spoon.

6. Place the sheet in the freezer for about 20 minutes until they are set. In a small bowl, melt the candy melts according to the package instructions. This part is especially important - don't overheat. As a result, you may actually cook the chocolate rather than melt it.

7. Dip one of your cake pops into the white candy coating. You want it to be evenly coated, but not dripping. Cover the entire cake pop with the sugar.

8. On your plastic spoon, place a drop of the white coating then place your cake pop on the spoon. Let it freeze for a few minutes and then there's your cake pops.

Recipe: Icebox Cake By Peyton Zusmer

Ingredients:

3 cups heavy cream
3 tablespoons sugar
1 tablespoon vanilla extract
2 (9-ounce) packages chocolate wafer cookies
Unsweetened cocoa (or chocolate shavings)



Directions:

-In a large bowl, beat cream, sugar and vanilla with an electric mixer on high speed until soft peaks form.
-On a flat serving plate, arrange 7 cookies side by side in a circle, keeping 1 cookie in the center.
-Spread with 1/2 cup whipped cream, making a 7-inch circle. Repeat with remaining cookies and cream, making 11 layers of cookies and ending with a layer of cream (there will be a few cookies left over).
-Cover with plastic wrap and refrigerate overnight.

-To serve, dust top lightly with cocoa powder or chocolate shavings.

My opinion

My family and I really enjoyed this cake because it has the perfect amount of sweet and fluffiness to it, especially when you let the cookies fully soften out. It becomes like a soft cake. (*Fun fact: this was my great-grandpa's favorite cake!*)

History

The National Biscuit Company, Nabisco, made their Famous Chocolate Wafers in 1924 along with a ginger and sugar version. They were lighter, thinner and crisper than an unfilled Oreo. They would have surely faded into the background if some 1930's women hadn't discovered that if you stack them, separated with a layer of whipped cream, it would soften into a cake overnight.

Pumpkin Cookies 🎲 By Cailin Melody

Makes 24 cookies

Ingredients - Pumpkin Cookies:

- 2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp baking powder
- Pinch of salt
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 1 Tbsp cinnamon
- 1/4 tsp ground nutmeg
- 1/4 tsp ground cloves
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 1 cup pumpkin purée

Ingredients - Cream Cheese Frosting:

- 4 oz cream cheese, at room temp
- 2 Tbsp butter
- 1 Tbsp milk
- 1/2 tsp vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup powdered sugar

Directions:

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 2. In a large bowl, cream the butter and both sugars together for 3 minutes.
- 3. Add in the pumpkin purée and vanilla. Mix until combined.
- 4. Fold in the flour, baking soda, baking powder, salt, cinnamon, nutmeg, and cloves until dough forms.
- 5. Roll dough into balls (should be about 2 Tbsp per ball) and place on a baking sheet lined with parchment paper and flatten them out a bit. (The dough is sticky so I recommend wetting your hands to help).
- 6. Bake for 14 minutes. Place on a cooling rack.
- 7. For the frosting cream together the cream cheese and butter until combined. Add in the vanilla, powdered sugar, and vanilla. Mix until smooth.
- 8. Frost the cookies once they have cooled completely. You can sprinkle some cinnamon on top for presentation.

- Tall bodies: Many anime characters have unusually tall or exaggerated bodies.


Anime can be classified into a few specific subgenres:

Now that we have reviewed many unique facts about anime, it is time to have some fun and draw an anime face!! :D




