Q 3~ Did you know how to speak English when you were in Ukraine?

Answer ~ No, I did not. Learning English wasn't hard, but I didn't know what was going on when I got here.

Q 4~ How do you feel about the current situation?

Answer ~ I think it's very sad that nothing has changed about Russia's behavior.

Q 5~ Do you think that they are close to solving the problem? Answer ~ No, Putin will never give up because of his ego.

~Coding Lesson 5: Variables, Operator and Making Scripts~ By Hasan Luqman

Welcome to the final lesson of my coding article series: Operators and Variables.

Even after you read, you will not know everything about coding, just the basics.

However, reading this will arm you with a great set of information to get you started on projects that took me years to get to.

So let's get started!

First, let's do variables.


When you go to the variables section in Scratch, you will see only 5 blocks:



These are the variable blocks. The "My variable" thing doesn't really matter for now. What does matter is that when you click on one of those bigger blocks, a dropdown menu appears, showing all the variables you have in your project. You can then select one and then the block will execute the task involving the variable you inserted. You can make new variables, just right click (two-fingered click on laptop) on the little round one. Variables are extremely vital to any coding project. To give you an example, here are all the variables I use in two of my most complex projects:

Minecraft Themes:


Minecraft Swordfighting Range:



But I should probably explain what variables even do.

That's where operators come in!

Operators are little green blocks, and none of them are big and blocky. Instead, they are meant to go *inside* other blocks, and other blocks go in them. Operators can be used to make computations within the game's code, or they can be used as triggers that will activate a script once certain conditions are met.



Remember those other round blocks I mentioned but didn't go into? This is where they come in.

Any round blocks, any operator blocks, numbers, even letters can fit in the white spots of operator blocks. The dark green spots can only hold the hexagonal blocks. Operators will fit into many other blocks. Their main use in my opinion, comes from a "Broadcast" block sending a message out to all sprites. If a sprite's scripts pick up the message that matches the message in the "Receive" Block at the top of the script, the rest of the script will go off. This is where operators come in, as if they are plugged into an "If, Then," block. Then you can use an operator as a kind of selective switch. If only certain conditions are met, then it will trigger the action placed inside of the "If, Then," block.

Here's an example of me using this system in an actual project:



(Links will be provided below btw. Go to the project and hit see inside to view code)

Notice how the variables inside the operators have to meet a certain requirement, in this case, the cursor location has to be bigger than 5 and another variable, the menu variable, must be 3. When

these conditions are met, the block inside of the "If, Then," block triggers, and the script lights up. You don't have to have multiple conditions in place, unless you want a specific thing to happen only at specific times. Instead of Variables being the "Requirements" you can also make some of the other round blocks serve as requirements. Here are all of them:



These can be put into the operators to compute and serve as conditions. For example: If you want a sprite to stop moving once it reaches a certain location, you can use the x position y position blocks, and put them into an operator. You can then put that into a "Wait Until," block. Then you could add a "Stop other scripts in sprite block" To turn off the code that's causing the sprite to move. This would look like:



And that covers the basics of operators and variables. There are a lot of things I didn't cover, mainly because I considered them a little extra, or they would make this article too long. I also simplified a lot, so if you are confused, go experiment and try to figure it out or poke around on YouTube or the like for tutorials that go much more in-depth. Finally, there are many features on Scratch, mainly extensions, that I didn't go over because those things are extra and things I don't fully understand yet. So, seek advice from those who can and do work with such things, and maybe you'll be working on projects more complex than I am. And with that, I must leave you now.

Morbius is a film about the origin of one of Marvel's most compelling and conflicted characters



that many people didn't enjoy. I myself did enjoy the film and hope to see what Marvel and Sony do with this character in the future. seen in *Spider-Man: Homecoming*. Vulture then talks to Morbius, revealing that he wants to get revenge on Spider-Man, and wants to recruit more people to get the job done. Morbius replies with one word: "Intriguing".

Marvel is most likely trying to set up a Sinister Six, a group of Spider-Man's most famous enemies. The thing that left people confused was exactly how did Vulture get into Sony's Spider-Man Universe? Wasn't Doctor Strange's spell supposed to just teleport the multiversal intruders back? Well, this mystery has been solved. Vulture must have slipped through the cracks, because he knew that Peter Parker was Spider-Man, and the spell was supposed to send people who knew Peter Parker was Spider-Man back to their original universes.

Now, the director of *Morbius* confirmed that it takes place in the same universe where *Venom* takes place, Sony's Spider-



Man Universe. He also confirmed that a Spider-Man does exist inside Sony's Spider-Man Universe, but he didn't say which one it was. It obviously can't be Tom Holland's Spider-Man, because his Spider-Man is from the Marvel Cinematic Universe, Marvel's main movie timeline. Tips and tricks in *Pokémon Legends: Arceus* By Wyatt Casdia and Hasan Luqman

About The Game

Pokémon Legends: Arceus is an open world version of the Pokémon series and takes place in the Hisuian region (ancient Sinnoh). At this time, people and Pokémon had not learned to coexist, and the people of Jubilife Village fear the Pokémon that surround them. Enter you, the player! The game starts with you falling out of the sky in front of a Pokémon Professor. When you come to your senses, Professor Laventon, the lead researcher in the Hisui region, is standing in front of you chasing the three Pokémon he was researching after they ran off.

Caching Regular Pokémon



The people in the Galaxy Expedition Team have recently invented Poké Balls, a device used to encapsulate Pokémon so they can be captured and studied in greater detail. The Galaxy Expedition Team wishes to study Pokémon to deepen their understanding of them, whether to avoid them or work with them.

To maximize caching efficiency, you should lure them in by throwing food and hit them in the back with your Poké Ball. Always remain crouching when pursuing any target, preferably in tall grass. Crouching in tall grass makes it next to impossible for even the keenest of Pokémon to notice you. A back strike increases the chances of successful capture. You can also wait until the target is asleep or resting, in which case they are easier to catch. Poké Balls in this game work surprisingly well compared to Poké Balls in other games, so you never need to stop using them. (Even though I have Ultra and Great Balls, I still use Poké balls more because other balls are overkill outside of certain scenarios.)

Another method is the traditional way when you battle it, to do this method you want to start the battle by throwing your Pokémon's Poké Ball at the back of the Pokémon to stun it in order to get a second or even third turn in the battle. After you get the Pokémon's hp in the red you should throw the Poké ball you think is appropriate for the Pokémon's capture. To make this easier, certain Pokémon can learn a move called False Swipe. False Swipe is a weak move with low power BUT what makes it good for Pokémon captures is that it will never K.O. The move will always leave the target Pokémon at 1 hp, making them easy to catch.

Catching Alpha Pokémon

Alpha Pokémon are powerful Pokémon that are bigger than average and have glowing red eyes. Special music plays when one is nearby. They are extremely powerful and overleveled compared to the surrounding Pokémon. There are 2 types of Alphas. Set Spawn Alphas will spawn in the same spot repeatedly, even if they are defeated or caught, they will respawn in that area. The other type is Random Spawn where an Alpha Pokémon spawns in place of a normal wild Pokémon. If you have a big group of a certain Pokémon, you are likely to find a Random Spawn Alpha. However, these Alphas don't spawn consistently, so if you find one, grab it, because you won't get a second chance for a long time. You can only catch Alpha Pokémon in battle except for when

you are one star more than the region it is found in and your entire team needs to be at least 20 levels higher than the Alpha you're trying to catch. The safest way is to get into the range where rings appear around them, then focus with the ZL button, then Throw your best Poké Ball at it when it's back is turned. Quickly dive for cover and stay crouched if the Pokémon breaks out. If it sees you, get as far away from it as possible until it doesn't see you and then go back. After a few rounds of this, it will stay caught. The other way is the riskiest way to catch them.

You hit them in the back with your strongest Pokémon's Poké Ball. This gets their hp in the red before you chuck your strongest level ball, preferably a Jet Ball, Ultra Ball, or Gigaton Ball, based on what Pokémon you are trying to catch. Even though your Pokémon may be overleveled, Alpha Pokémon can still do massive amounts of damage, so be wary and have many Potions stocked.

Miscellaneous Tips

Pokémon catch rates vary based on the species and the balls you use, so a capture can seem random. However, there is a way to know if you have secured a Pokémon. If the Poké Ball only does a short bounce with the Pokémon inside, you caught it. However, if it does a big bounce with multiple jets of steam, there is a good chance that the Pokémon will bust out. Even if you see this bounce, there are times the Pokémon won't break out and you'll catch it.

Never try to catch a Pokémon before you have a focus on it. Focus is achieved by getting close enough to a Pokémon until you see rings around it, then holding down the ZL button.

Heavy balls, Leaden Balls, and Gigaton Balls are all very heavy and don't go far if thrown, so only use them when engaged in battle. On the other hand, Feather Balls, Wing Balls, and Jet Balls go very far and fast when thrown. Throw your Pokémon at trees, specific rocks, or at items that stand out. Your Pokémon will grab whatever it finds and bring them back to you, gaining a tiny bit of XP in the process. Some examples are shown below:

In the level "The Battle of Blizzard Bridge," a mini-boss level full of action, you can actually fight extra mini-bosses on top of the bridge by finding a tomato and jumping up, entering a window and using a warp star.

- ½ cup rolled oats
- ½ cup milk, or any preferred milk
- ½ cup Greek yogurt
- 1 teaspoon maple syrup
- 1 teaspoon cocoa powder
- 2 strawberries, diced

- 1. In a mason jar, measure and add the rolled oats. Next, measure and add the milk.
- 2. Measure the Greek yogurt and add it to the oats and milk. Using a spoon may be useful to help scoop the Greek yogurt out of the measuring cup.
- 3. Next, measure and add the cocoa powder. Using the same measuring spoon, add the maple syrup.
- 4. Mix with a spoon until the mixture is well combined.
- 5. Lastly, add diced strawberries on top of the mixture, seal the jar, and put it in the fridge overnight.

I really enjoyed this quick and easy recipe and I hope you will give it a try. I did think it was a little bit too sweet. I recommend adding a little less maple syrup, changing the measurement from 1 teaspoon to ½ teaspoon.

Sound

Manifest it, I finessed it, Take my pen and write some love letters to heaven". In the song "pov" however, Ariana sings about wanting to see herself the way her partner sees her. In one part of the song, she sings "I wanna love me. The way that you love me, Ooh for all of my pretty. And all my ugly too, I'd love to see you from your point of view."

Music Videos/Singles

During this new era, we got several music videos for the album. "Positions" is the first one. Ariana plays the president in the music video. It matches the song perfectly because it shows Ariana switching up her positions as a president while the song talks about how she would do anything for the people she cares about. With the help of the music video, the song went to #1 on the charts. Another music video was more of a dance video for the last song on the main album, "pov". Ariana released the video to celebrate the sixmonth anniversary of the album.

Deluxe

Four months after the album release, Ariana put out 5 new songs for the deluxe version of the album. The songs included "Test Drive", "Worst Behavior", "Main Thing", "Someone Like U" and the "34+35 Remix". The deluxe edition was released on February 19th. The songs were instantly popular, especially "Test Drive" and "Worst Behavior". My favorite track from the deluxe is "Someone Like U".

Positions Tour

While Ariana is not touring the album at the moment, in an interview with Zach Sang she said she would love to tour *Positions* and her 7th album together just like she did for her *Thank U Next* album and *Sweetener* albums. However, don't expect a tour or a new album anytime soon because she is currently busy with her role as Glinda in the film adaptation of *Wicked*. She also has her makeup line, r.e.m. beauty.

Positions Live Performances

To end off the Positions era, Ariana and the music network Vevo released live performances for 6 songs from the album: (not in order) "pov", "My Hair", "Safety Net" with Ty Dolla \$ign, "34+35", "Off The Table" with The Weeknd, and "Positions" The live performance for "Positions" was so good that it was nominated for a Grammy for Best Pop Solo Performance. The live performances also helped increase streams and sales for a lot of the songs on the album. The song "Positions" was actually played during the Fortnite x Ariana Grande event called the Rift Tour that took place in August of 2021. Since then, *Positions* is still on the charts, and has not left since its release back in 2020.

Recipe: Vanilla Cupcakes By Alison Coppinger

Ingredients

1 1/4 cups all-purpose flour

1 ¼ teaspoons baking powder

1/4 teaspoon salt

3/4 cup granulated sugar

¹/₄ cup unsalted butter (at room temperature)

2 eggs

2 teaspoons vanilla extract

½ cup heavy cream

Icing ingredients (optional)

4 cups powdered sugar

½ cup salted butter (at room temperature)

2 teaspoons vanilla extract

2 - 3 tablespoons heavy cream

Any color food coloring if you desire (I used pink)





Steps for Cupcakes:

- -Preheat the oven to 350°F.
- -Line a cupcake pan with paper liners.
- -Combine flour, baking powder and salt in a small bowl.
- -In a separate bowl, combine the butter and sugar and mix with an electric mixer until blended.
- -Add the eggs, then the vanilla to butter mixture.
- -Gradually add the flour mixture to the butter mixture, alternating with the heavy cream, until everything is well combined.
- -Fill each cupcake liner about 1/2 to 2/3rds full.
- -Bake in the oven for 12-15 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean.
- -Remove cupcakes from the pan and allow them to cool.

Steps for Icing (optional):

-In medium bowl, mix powdered sugar and butter with spoon or electric mixer on low speed. Stir in vanilla and 1 tablespoon of the heavy cream. Gradually beat in just enough remaining cream to make frosting smooth and spreadable. After cupcakes are cool, add icing!

<u>Me:</u> These cupcakes were very sugary and with icing on top, it made it 100 times more sweet. If you love sugar, these are the cupcakes for you. My family reviewed them just for this newspaper article!

<u>Dad:</u> Was pretty good, 8/10 rating. Cupcake tastes a little like corn bread and the icing was very sugary. So, if you like sugar like I do, I think you will enjoy the icing a lot.

Mom: 9/10 rating. Cupcake was delicious and perfectly cooked. The only complaint I would have is that it was slightly dry. The icing was beautiful and very sweet. Good consistency.

Brother: 6/10 rating. I had no icing and it tasted like flour.
