# What I learned from Rohan Murphy By Hasan Luqman

We all know about the lives of some disabled people. We may know people who are blind, deaf, or born with life-threatening illnesses. If you had one of these conditions, how would you feel? Some people would just think of giving up. Others take what they have and move on, becoming incredible people in their own right. No example of this kind of person shines brighter than Rohan Murphy.

Rohan Murphy was born with extremely severe birth defects. He was missing a hip joint on his right side and half a joint on the other. These conditions led to his legs to being amputated at a very young age. What's left are his tiny thighs, so he can't walk. He walks on his hands, but only at home. In public, he uses a wheelchair to move around.

So, why does all this matter to me? As you may know, I joined the East Islip Wrestling team in January. Since then, we have participated in (and won) 7 matches. In February, we were surprised with a special guest: former East Islip student, Rohan Murphy.

Murphy's career comes has lead him to become a motivational speaker. He travels and speaks to students across the country. He told us that he would choose no other job. Murphy stands at approximately 3 feet tall and weighs in at 118 pounds (56 kg). He couldn't participate in sports at first, even with prosthetics, which he stopped using because they were heavy. His thighs couldn't support them, and they were uncomfortable.

While a student at Islip Terrace Junior High,

Murphy was an equipment manager for various sports teams. With the help of our own Mr. Croteau, he started wrestling as a 9<sup>th</sup> grader at EIHS and went on to wrestle in college at Penn State.

By the time I arrived at practice on February 17th, he was there, and wrestled almost every kid on our team, including me, and won. We asked him many questions. See page 2 for the Q&A session.

# Continued from page 1 - Rohan Murphy interview (questions posed by the members of the EIMS wrestling team)

#### Q: "Can you drive?"

A: "I have to get the car specially modified. Instead of pedals, my steering wheel is modeled to work one-handed while my other hand operates a lever that I can pull or push to brake or accelerate, so when I'm driving, it looks like I'm playing a video game."

## Q: "Were you in the Olympics?"

A: "I did do Olympic weightlifting, but I don't do that or heavy bench pressing anymore to prevent damage to my arms."

#### Q: "Does everything in your house have to be downsized to accommodate you?"

A: "Actually, I live in a pretty decent sized house. I really don't use the high kitchen cabinets as much, but at first glance, it looks like any other house."

## Q: "What do you like to do?"

A: "Well, I like watching sports, especially wrestling and football, and I obviously wrestle, but other than that, I'm kind of a boring guy honestly."

#### Q: "What would your reaction be if you suddenly had legs like a normal person?"

A: "I think I would just be shocked, then go for a walk in a public place, like a park or something."

#### Q: "How did your parents feel when you tried out wrestling? Were they worried or nervous?"

A: "I guess they were a little apprehensive at first but calmed down when they knew I was going to be ok."

#### Q: "What was your quickest match?"

A: "I think at some point in college, I was going against a big person, but he wasn't well conditioned, and I pinned him in 9 seconds."

### Q: "Were you ever badly injured in wrestling?"

A: "Not really. I'm pretty sure most of the injuries in wrestling come from being slammed into the ground from standing up. With me, you have to wrestle on your knees, so that can't happen."

What he spoke to us about especially was the effect some things can have on your mentality, and what effect your mentality can have on the things you do. "I think the hardest thing about wrestling is that it's an emotional sport." He told us. "If you don't have the mindset, the determination, you can't succeed." He goes on: "When I was in wrestling camp, it was a lot of hard work. I had the mindset, the willpower. I *wanted* to do it. And I got it done. My first match was scary. But I thought I could defeat the other guy, and when I did, it became constant. I can win. I will win. I will succeed. And now, here I am."

To wrap things up, Rohan Murphy is an amazing person. He saw the light in his own situation. Sometimes I wish some of us could be like that. He inspired me. I hope he inspires you too. Thanks to Coach Croteau for arranging this visit.

## Cookie Run: Legendary and Ancient - Contributors: Diana Sobel and Catherine Sause

Frost Queen Cookie: "You cannot defy the cycle of life."



**Frost Queen Cookie** was released on November 19, 2021, along with **Cotton Cookie**. She is currently the best magic cookie in Cookie Run Kingdom. She has legendary status and is also the most sought-after cookie in the game. Frost Queen is in the middle position and has a **0.054%** chance of being pulled from the Gacha, and her soulstones have a **0.308%** chance of being pulled. Her event was called the **Frost Crystal Gacha** and you use Frost Crystals that you get by completing missions. Frost Queen's attack freezes enemies and pauses their cooldown times and does

**67.8** points of damage (+**0.9** for each level), called **Freezing Squall**. In the event story, she is known as the Frost Witch who took Cotton Cookie's friend, Sherbet Cookie so he can become one with the life force of cookies that is a Giant Snowflake. I don't get it either.

**Sea Fairy Cookie**: "I feel the warmth of your heart."



Sea Fairy Cookie was revealed on January 21, 2021 and became playable on June 21, 2021 in the first half of the **Tropical Soda** Islands Update, along with Sorbet Shark Cookie. The event to pull her was called the Tide Shard Gacha and was available from June 22 to August 3, 2021. You used special currency called Tide Shards that you collected by completing missions. She is currently the best Bomber cookie in the game, legendary status, and in middle position. She has a 0.054% chance of being pulled from the regular Gacha and her Soulstones have a 0.308% chance of being pulled. Soulstones are things used to upgrade her and bake her if you have 20 of them, for

you poor people that didn't randomly get her like I did. Her backstory is very mysterious, saying that she was "frozen from a curse long, long ago, but perhaps, because of her grieving heart, her soul was frozen beyond magic." What's also interesting is that in the failed animation, she is frozen once again and her sword has fallen, suggesting that her life force is tied to it.

Dark Cacao Cookie: "Great strength leads to bitter consequences."



Dark Cacao Cookie is the 3rd playable ancient cookie in the game. He is the strongest charge cookie, leading your team into battle (he is front position) with his GIGANTIC sword and weird shoulder square Oreos. Dark Cacao was released on February 24th, 2022, along with Affogato Cookie. His event is called the Nether Gacha (still going on right now) and you used items you got from completing missions. For the special gacha, he has a 0.301% chance of being pulled, and his soulstones have a

1% chance. But in the regular one, he only has a 0.054 chance. He is **Dark Choco Cookie's** father and is much better than him. (NOTE: Choco is an epic cookie that isn't good - if you get Choco, don't upgrade him!) His special skill is "**Solemn Judgment**" which is an area of attack effect where he hits everyone with his giant GrapeJam Sword which causes zap damage and just generally does a lot of damage. (His soulstone is pretty judgey too.)

Hollyberry Cookie: "Blow the horn! Hollyberry Cookie has arrived!" Hollyberry Cookie was revealed on January 21, 2021 and was released September 2, 2021. In the storyline, she is one of the five ancient heroes, released with Raspberry Cookie. She was the second Ancient Cookie to be released. She was part of the Heart of Courage and Passion Update, having her own event called the Light of Passion Gacha. She has a 0.301% chance of being pulled in the normal gacha, while her soulstones have a 1% chance of being pulled. Before, she was the rarest cookie in the game, but her title was snatched by some very cold hands, none other than Frost Queen Cookie (see info on previous page). In the storyline, she also has two granddaughters, Princess Cookie and Tiger Lily Cookie. She is a defense cookie who proudly sits in the front of the team, giving her allies moral support and cleaning her shield. Her skill, called "Oath on the Shield", summons a shield effect to her allies, absorbing a portion of their DMG but does not apply to indirect and continuous DMG, and does 185.5% single hit DMG (+2.53% DMG per level). Now, that's impressive!



#### Pure Vanilla Cookie: "The truth always prevails!"

Pure Vanilla Cookie was revealed on January 21, 2021 and released 3 months later on April 8, 2021. In the storyline, he is one of the five ancient heroes, with White Lily Cookie (non-playable), Dark Cacao Cookie, and Golden Cheese Cookie (non-playable), and king of the Vanilla Kingdom. He is the first ever Ancient Cookie and is a fan favorite. When released, he had his own event called the Light of Truth Gacha. Meanwhile now, he only has a 0.054% chance of being pulled in the gacha, while his soulstones have a 0.308% chance of being pulled. He is known as Healer Cookie earlier on in the storyline. He also founded the Vanilla Kingdom, and after it falls, he goes undercover as Healer Cookie, and helps Gingerbrave, Strawberry Cookie, Wizard Cookie, Chili Pepper Cookie, and Custard Cookie III find the vanilla kingdom, along with Black Raisin Cookie. His special attack, Love and Peace, covers your party in shields and replenishes their health. He stands proudly at the back of the team, while he makes sure he will not falter.

# Hurricane safety and preparation By John Haanraadts

I am sure everyone who is reading this has heard the word **Hurricane**. When you think of hurricanes, you might think of some clouds and rain but, hurricanes are much worse than that.

#### **Hurricane effects**

Hurricanes can be deadly. They bring high winds and **torrential** rain. For a storm to be called a hurricane, it has to have winds of at least 75 mph (miles per hour). Hurricanes create big, strong waves called **storm surge**. Storm surge can bring flooding as high as 20 feet. Hurricanes can also bring over 1 foot of rain. Thunderstorms are another part of hurricanes. Thunderstorms usually form on the back end of the storm.

#### How a hurricane forms

Atlantic hurricanes tend to form off the west coast of Africa. Storm systems travel west across the Atlantic Ocean. As they travel, they go over warm waters which gives the storm energy due to the moisture. The storm forms into an area of low pressure. When more energy comes, it turns into a tropical disturbance with winds at least 20 mph in the center. When the storm forms a clear area of low pressure, it turns into a tropical depression. A tropical depression has at least 30 mph winds. If the winds go to 40 mph, then it is called a tropical storm and the National Hurricane Center will give the storm a name. If the storm stays over warm waters and doesn't hit **wind shear**, then it will form into a hurricane. When the storm goes over land, it dies down due to less moisture.

#### How to prepare for hurricanes

If you live near the ocean, you should watch out for hurricanes. Board up your windows to protect them from high winds. If you need to evacuate, bring your pets, important documents, and some money. Bring a toy and treats for your pets. Bring food and water as well. If a hurricane is forecasted to hit, keep watching the weather forecast for updates. Make sure you have a flashlight and that your mobile devices are charged in case the power goes out. Remember, never underestimate the weather.

# The Beatles By Kate Habel



The Beatles were an English rock band formed in 1960. The members included Paul McCartney, George Harrison, John Lennon and Ringo Starr. They were originally from Liverpool, England. Some consider

them the most influential band ever. Lennon and McCartney are among the most iconic artists and songwriters of all time.

The band evolved from Lennon's old group, the Quarrymen. They began as just a small group playing at clubs around Hamburg and Liverpool. A man named Stuart Sutcliffe also played bass for the group. The group of 3, McCartney, Lennon and Harrison went through many drummers before they asked Starr to join them.

In 1962, producer George Martin helped them succeed after their first hit, "Love Me Do." By 1964 the boys were stars! From there, they only got bigger. They soon came out with albums such as Rubber Soul, Revolver, A Hard Day's Night, Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club, The Beatles (also known as the The White Album) and the iconic Abbey Road. They helped to make further advancements in album art, music videos and electronic music.

In 1970, the group broke up but each member went on to have a solo career. Some of their solo songs include "Wonderful Christmastime" by Paul McCartney, "Imagine" by John Lennon, and "Got My Mind Set on You" by George Harrison. Paul McCartney even sang a song with Michael Jackson called "The Girl Is Mine" in 1982.

Some members are still performing. In September of 2021, Ringo Starr released an EP called *Change the World*. In February of 2022, McCartney announced his **Got Back** tour which includes many dates in the U.S. this spring and summer.

#### Lovejoy- A look into indie rock By Jasmin Law

If you're into indie music or listen to the indie playlists on Spotify, you might have heard of Lovejoy. Now, if you're reading this and wondering "Who is Lovejoy?", then let me bring you down a rabbit hole. Lovejoy is a British indie band that consists of four

members: lead singer and guitarist Wilbur Soot, guitarist Ash Kabosu, bassist Joe Goldsmith, and drummer Mark Boardman. Most Lovejoy fans know about the band through Wilbur and his work from the album *Your City Gave Me Asthma* or the song "Your

New Boyfriend". Not only does Wilbur make sad songs but he streams them on Twitch for 4.3 million followers with content like chat, Minecraft, and the geography game GeoGuessr.



The official Lovejoy Twitter account was created in November of 2020 and seemed to start out as Wilbur's alt account. But on May 8, 2021, Wilbur announced that the account would turn into a platform for his new band. With some behind the scenes beforehand, Lovejoy released their first EP, *Are You Alright?* on May 9, 2021 with 4 tracks. They also released two music videos on the Lovejoy YouTube channel at that time for *One Day* and T*aunt*, featuring fellow Twitch streamer, GeorgeNotFound.

The band then worked for five months to bring the release of a mini album called *Pebble Brain* on October 13, 2021. This album has seven tracks, including a remake of an old Wilbur Soot song, "It's All Futile! It's All Pointless!" and three music videos to go along with it. The first music video was for "Model Buses", a song about the Prime Minister of England, Boris Johnson. The second music video was for "Concrete", my personal favorite on *Pebble Brain*. The third, and final music video for the mini album was for "It's All Futile! It's All Pointless".

Lovejoy's most recent project was "Knee Deep at ATP", a single that almost became an EP which is a cover from one of Wilbur's favorite bands, Los Campesinos! The single was released in December and the official video, created by Wilbur's old thumbnail artist Anni Scivious, was released in January.

As of March 2022, Lovejoy has 1.9 million monthly listeners on Spotify. Sooner or later, they'll have another song out and I strongly encourage anyone who likes indie music to listen to them because they're probably my favorite artist besides Mitski, which is another story and I'm out of time so goodbye for now!

## **SCP**

sandbox game, which means that it gives the player lots of freedom. There are no quests or side jobs. The goal is to get to the "End" dimension and kill the Ender Dragon. How you get there is up to you. *Minecraft* has become a smashing success since its final release in 2011, and it is still gaining more interest to this day.

#### Deltarune Chapter 2

Deltarune is a game created by Toby Fox in 2018. After the success of *Undertale* in 2015 which was also a game Fox created, he decided to release Deltarune in 2018. Deltarune was originally a project thought up in 2012 before Undertale. Back then, Fox was just a kid creating bad ROM hacks and dumb games. He was originally going to make Deltarune but put it on the backburner when Undertale kicked off. Deltarune was massively successful when the first chapter was released. In September of 2021, for *Undertale's* 6th Anniversary, Deltarune Chapter 2 was released in a livesteam event. Its success was almost immediate.

The game blew up as being a funny roleplaying game and a meme hub. Fox's comeback was definitely a good one.



#### Genshin Impact

This game was developed by Chinese game developer miHoYo and was released in 2020. However, it gained popularity in 2021, becoming one of the most popular games of the year. *Genshin Impact* is an RPG that involves a traveler exploring the world of Teyvat to find their sibling. This game was a smash hit, reaching the top of the most popular apps on the iTunes store, and being awarded 1st Place in the PlayStation 2021 Partner Awards and 1st runner up for Music Awards. miHoYo also makes games like *Honkai Impact 3rd* and *Tears of Themis*. They were definitely a huge contributor to gaming in 2021. (If you would like to learn more about this game, read my analysis of *Genshin Impact* in the January 2021 issue.)



There were a lot of smash hits this year, way more than I could list. However, I believe all of these games were highly respected among the gaming community, and we are awaiting more great games in 2022!

# Women role models of past times By Christina Manzi

#### **Elizabeth The First**

Elizabeth I was the 3rd female queen of England. She was from the Tudor dynasty. She was known as the Good Queen Bess and Gloriana. She was born September 7th, 1533, to

Henry VIII and Anne Boleyn. Her mother was beheaded when Elizabeth was 3. She claimed she would never marry after she saw the fate of her mother and her five stepmothers.

Elizabeth was Queen of England and Ireland from November 17, 1558, until her death in 1603. She is most famous for establishing Protestantism in England, defeating the Spanish armada in 1588, never marrying, and keeping peace in her country (which was previously divided). She did have a lover, Sir Robert Dudley, but never ended up marrying him. She was not in the line of succession and only became Queen under the King's third succession act.

She spoke and read at least seven languages. She was the last Tudor monarch since she had no children. Having the need for an heir, she made James VI, her cousin's son, heir to the throne. Because of this, he ended up becoming the first ruler of England to rule two countries. Unfortunately, in 1603, Elizabeth I died. Many believe it was due to blood poisoning from using lead-based makeup for years.

#### **Catherine the Great**

Catherine the Great was known by many names: Sophie Friederike Auguste, Prinzessin Von Anhalt-Zerbst and Russian Ekaterina Velikaya, or Catherine II. She was also known as Yekaterina Alekseyevna meaning Ekaterina Alekseevna in English. She was born May 2, 1729, in Poland, to a poor prince/general and duchess. Catherine was raised Lutheran but converted to the Russian Orthodox faith so she could marry Peter III, the heir to the throne of Russia.

Catherine and Peter's marriage was not a great one. They loved each other at times but also hated each other and it was mostly a loveless situation. Catherine also believed Peter was childish. Catherine was sick of her husband's temper and hearing him humiliate her. On June 28, 1762, Catherine rallied troops to support her and her lover, Grigory Orlov, in a coup to overthrow and kill Peter III. She ended up feeling bad for her husband and only imprisoned him, but Orlov killed him. Catherine named herself Empress Catherine II, and her son Paul was to be her heir. Catherine died November 17, 1796, from a stroke.

Catherine the Great is famous for using a coup to gain power, changing the law code, expanding Russia's territories and being a great military leader. To this day, she is the longest reigning female ruler in Russian history. She successfully led the Russians against the Ottoman Empire (which was believed to be the most powerful empire of their time). She greatly improved Russian education. She established the first institute of formal education of females.

#### Sor Juana Inés de la Cruz

You may wonder who this woman is and how she is a role model. Sor Juana Ines de la Cruz was the first female feminist of the new world. She was born on November 12, 1651, during the Spanish colonial period. She was the illegitimate child of Spanish Captain Pedro Manuel de Asbaje and Isabel Ramirez.

Soon after her birth, Pedro left her, her mom and her sisters. Luckily, Juana's mother was a strong woman. She moved in with her very rich father and did things that were deemed manly at the time and not something a woman should do. This made men gasp when they saw what she was doing, like owning land and being outspoken about politics. This may have pushed Juana to be more outspoken and a feminist.

She grew up at her maternal grandfather's home. She started following her sister to a school for girls and convinced her sister's teacher to teach her how to read when she was three. She then started reading books in her grandfather's library. She begged her mother to send her to school dressed as a boy because girls were not allowed to go to a prestigious school at the time. Her mother refused.

Juana was taken under the wings of a noble lady, and she became a lady in waiting. She stayed with them for five years. She joined a convent because she wanted to be free and be able to study anytime. Juana started writing poetry. She sent a poem to Sor Philothea, in which she wrote about her

intelligence, and how she believes in a woman's right to an education. She was forced to give up her writing by the bishop of Puebla. Juana died in 1695 after catching the plague while caring for her sick sisters.

#### **Dian Fossey**

Dian Fossey was born in 1932 and loved animals from a young age. She visited Dr. Louis Leakey and later said it was a pivotal moment in her life. They both shared a belief in long term field studies on great apes. She then went on an expedition to Virunga mountains. It was there she had her first encounter with gorillas. She went back to her home so she could work to earn more money to pay back loans and save for another expedition.

On her next expedition, she set up camp and saw a lone gorilla sunning himself. The gorillas used to run and hide from her when she watched them from a distance but eventually, after mimicking their vocal commands and imitating their daily activities like scratching and feeding, she earned their trust. To recognize who was who, she drew their unique "noseprints" for each gorillas. She also kept a record of their daily interactions and learned a lot from their behavior.

She became more aware of the threats faced by gorillas from cattle herders and poachers; they are normally not targets, but they could still get stuck in traps meant for other animals. Dian fought both poachers and herds of cattle getting into her research area through uncommon methods like wearing masks to scare poachers; burning snares, spray-painting cattle to discourage herders from bringing them into the park, and occasionally taking on poachers directly, forcing confrontation. As a last resort, Dian used her own funds to help

purchase boots, uniforms, food and provide better wages to encourage park wardens to be more active in enforcing anti-poaching laws. These efforts spawned the first Karisoke anti-poaching patrols, whose job was to protect the gorillas in the research area.

During her research she made an incredibly close bond with a gorilla called Digit. He had a damaged finger on his right hand, which was how he got his name. Digit was important to Dian because she saw him as playful and curious while also being gentle and trusting. Tragically, on December 31, 1977, Digit was killed by poachers while protecting his group. That was when Dian declared war on the poachers.

Sadly, a few weeks before her 54th birthday, Dian was murdered in her cabin. It was obvious someone broke in but it seemed robbery was not the motive. The case has never been solved, and she was buried with Digit and the gorillas she befriended.

It's important to look after these animals. Nearly 3000 gorillas, chimpanzees, orangutans, and bonobos are illegally killed or stolen from the wild each year. Through persistent and brave commitment, Dian made positive changes. Now let's help keep her changes.



These women are important because they led the way for others. It's great to have role models, especially when growing up, but it's also important to know that you are your own person. At least we live in a world where people have paved a way for us and can help motivate us to keep going. Sor Juana de la Cruz did not give up when people took everything she loved away from her.

## ~Coding Lesson 3: Event Blocks~ By Hasan Luqman

This is the third installment in our coding lesson saga, and probably the most important. Today we're here to talk about Scratch Event Blocks, which are in the yellow slide on the side of your screen. There are 8 different Event Blocks (see below). Event blocks are like a trigger. They cause scripts (strips of code attached to it) to happen.



For example, if you put a series of blocks under the sprite window will trigger the script (or scripts).

The block allows you to pick from many different triggers: the arrow keys, the number keys, the spacebar, and every letter key. The Sprite Clicked block will start a script that is attached to it if the sprite is clicked.

The block (it can also have "timer" instead of "loudness") goes in tandem with the lesson we'll do on variables, sensors, and operators.

blocks are in my opinion, the most useful block in the game. The "Broadcast" block on the right allows a sprite to send a message to another sprite. This block can also be attached to scripts. The message can have any name you want, and there can be multiple. The "When I receive" block can have a script attached to it. So we can tell a sprite to send a specific message to another sprite, and the sending and receiving is instant. When the other sprite receives the message, if it has a script connected to the receive block with the same message entered, it will carry out that script.

This might be confusing at first, but do try it out for yourself, and you'll quickly get it. And we will discuss how to make scripts later, so don't worry!






# **Ariana Grande Perfumes By Ace Green**

First, preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Next, in a medium bowl whisk together flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt. In a separate large bowl, use an electric mixer to cream together butter and sugar. In the same bowl you used for the butter and sugar, mix in the egg, egg yolk, and vanilla. Then add the dry ingredients to the large bowl and mix until combined.

Put parchment paper on a cookie sheet and place your cookie dough in little balls 2 inches apart on the cookie sheet. Bake the cookies into the oven for 9 -11 minutes. Let them cool down and enjoy!

#### Review:

My opinion on this recipe is that it was easy and hard to make. The only hard/confusing part for me was separating the egg yolk. What you can do is use an empty water bottle to help. First, crack an egg into a bowl. Then squeeze the empty water bottle and place over the egg yolk. When you release your grip, the yolk will be sucked inside the bottle. Next, put the water bottle over the bowl you'll need to put the egg yolk into and squeeze the water bottle again. The rest is pretty easy. I thought these cookies were the perfect amount of chewy and crunchy. They were delicious.

To make a bracelet, animal, object, or any other creation you will need materials. You can buy a Rainbow Loom kit from Amazon and have it delivered to your door. You can also find one at your local Target, Marshall's or Walmart.

#### Your kit should include:

- The pegboard (to make your creations on you can also break this apart in pieces to help you create the specific design you want)
- A Rainbow Loom hook
- C or S clips (these attach to the ends of you rubber bands to keep everything together)
- 500+ rubber bands in an assortment of unique colors

Once you have your materials, all you have to do is find something you want to make. You can find a tutorial, use your imagination, or look at the instructions on the Rainbow Loom package. It will show you two simple ways to make basic Rainbow Loom bracelets. Then, create! The photo below of the penguin is one of my creations. Have fun!:)

# Winter Olympics 2022: Figure Skating By Danna Perez

Figure skating is one of the most popular and fiercest sports at the Winter Olympics. One slight error during a performance and not only the chance of winning an Olympic gold medal goes up in smoke but also the probability of getting injured, considering the speed reached when they execute a spinning jump.

Figure skating began in 1850 when skaters started experimenting with different jumps and spins on ice. Figure skating was first included at the London Summer Games in 1908 and then again in 1920 in Antwerp, Belgium before being moved permanently to the program of the Winter Games.

This year, the 2022 Winter Olympic Games were held in Beijing, China. There were five events in the figure skating competition: men's single skating, women's single skating, ice dance, pair skating, and the team event. Let's take a minute to read more about this amazing sport that keeps the audience with nerves on edge!

#### Women's and Men's Singles

Women's and Men's Singles are very similar. At the higher levels, competition is divided into two parts: the short program, which is skated first, and the free skate. Both programs display the perfection, athleticism, and talent needed with the sport of figure skating. The flow and motion of the skaters must be graceful. The competitors receive scores based on their performance from a board of judges.

#### **Ice Dance**

Ice dance, like pairs skating, features a male and female skating in unison, which means their

moves and dance have to be simultaneously in perfect harmony. Instead of performing jumps and spins, they complete difficult dance patterns and step sequences while showing exceptional interpretation of music and accurate steps.

The ice dance competition consists of two segments: a rhythm dance and a free dance. The rhythm dance has required elements, while the free dance features step sequences.

#### **Pairs Skating**

At first, skaters in pairs events simply danced on ice but over time this discipline became more "acrobatic". It includes the athleticism of singles skating with the challenge to combine throw jumps, twist lifts, overhead lifts and other acrobatic moves. Each movement is performed at the same time, requiring a significant amount of timing, perfect synchronization and trust between partners. Skaters can perform a number of elements at a distance. Pairs Skating includes a short and free program.

#### **Team event**

The team event has the same judging system as the rest of the skating events. This event has eight parts: a short program and a free skate for all four categories (men's singles, women's singles, ice dance, and pairs). Points are awarded in each category for the short program. Teams with the five highest point totals move on to the free skate portion. Of course, the team with the most points overall is named the gold medal winner.

Figure Skating is my favorite sport to watch in the Winter Olympics. What I like about it is the amazing and beautiful performances. The skaters are perfectly synchronized in every move, but behind those few minutes of ice skating are countless hours of training.

This is a very difficult sport, lovely to watch but it takes a lot of discipline, hard work and perseverance for the athletes. These are qualities that are required to succeed not just in a sports competition, but in life itself.

# Peanut Butter Cookie Recipe By Cailin Melody

Oven Temp: 375° F

#### **Ingredients List**

- 1 1/4 cups flour
- 3/4 tsp. baking soda
- 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1/2 cup shortening
- 1/2 cup peanut butter
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1 egg, beaten

#### Step-by-Step

- Sift the flour, then measure and put in a mixing bowl. Add baking soda, baking powder, and salt, then sift again.
- In another bowl, cream the shortening and peanut butter together with an electric mixer. Gradually add the sugars and cream together thoroughly. Add the well-beaten egg. Mix together thoroughly.
- Combine the dry ingredients with the creamed mixture and chill for 1 hour.
- Preheat the oven to 375 degrees.
- Form the cookie dough into balls about 1 inch in diameter. Place them 2 inches apart on a lightly greased and floured cookie sheet.
- Flatten each cookie ball with a fork dipped in flour, making a criss-cross pattern.
- Bake for 8-10 minutes.
- Cool for 10 minutes. Remove from the pan to a wire rack.

#### **Thoughts**

I personally really enjoyed this recipe and highly recommend it. It was easy to make and my family loved it but, I also think that it lacked a good peanut butter taste. I would recommend increasing the peanut butter from ½ cup to ¾ cup.
