NFL Head Coach firings of the 2020 Season By Michael Kraft

How many National Football League (NFL) head coaches were fired recently? Three within 1 week! Yes, three NFL head coaches were fired in early January 2021. Adam Gase of the New York Jets, Doug Marrone of the Jacksonville Jaguars, and Anthony Lynn of the Los Angeles Chargers. Earlier this season, three other coaches got fired: Matt Patricia from the Detroit Lions, Bill O'Brien from the Houston Texans and, Atlanta Falcons head coach, Dan Quinn. Let's explore the details surrounding each situation.

Anthony Lynn led the Chargers to a 7-9 season in 2020. He was the head coach for the chargers for the past 4 years. He went 33-31 in the 4 seasons he coached for Los Angeles. He signed a one-year extension in the off-season, losing seven games by one score.

Doug Marrone was fired a day after the Jacksonville Jaguars lost to the Indianapolis Colts. The Jaguars went 1-15 this past season which got them the first overall draft pick in the 2021 NFL Draft. That was the worst record all time in franchise history for the Jaguars. Although he still had one year remaining on his contract, the Jaguars parted ways with Marrone.

Adam Gase was fired after the loss to the Patriots. He led the Jets to a 2-14 record in the 2020 season. The Jets CEO Christopher Johnson said that Gase was a brilliant offensive mind at the start of the season. Gase was the Jets coach for only two years despite him having a contract through 2022. Gase had a record of 9-23 in those two seasons he coached for the Jets. The Jets set a franchise record of having a 13-game losing streak.



Bill O'Brien was fired back in October 2020 after the Texans were 0-4. It was O'Brien's 7th season as head coach and he had taken over as General Manager back in January of 2020. O'Brien had a 52-48 record in all 7 seasons he was with the Texans. He also had four divisional titles with the Texans. The Texans never made the AFC conference championship though. The Texans have interviewed 3 people so far for the position: Jim Caldwell, Marvin Lewis and Joe Brady.

Dan Quinn was fired on October 11, 2020 after starting the season with a 0-5 record for the Falcons. The Falcons also fired their General Manager Thomas Dimitroff. It was Quinn's 6th season as a head coach for the Falcons, having an all-time record of 43-42. They made it to the Super Bowl back in 2016 but they lost to the Patriots. So far, the Falcons have interviewed Raheem Morris, Eric Bieniemy, Robert Saleh, and Joe Brady for the position.

Finally, Matt Patricia of the Detroit Lions was fired back on November 28, 2020. It was Patricia's third year as the head coach and his record was 13-29-1 since he took over. Detroit has gone 26 years without a divisional title, last claiming the crown back in 1993. They have not won a playoff game since the 1991 season. The Lions have interviewed Eric Bieniemy, Marvin Lewis, Darrell Bevel and Robert Salah.

That is a summary of all of the head coaches fired this past season in the NFL. Where will they all go? That remains to be seen.

NHL: In the Bubble By Emilia Cicale

No more sports?

During the months of March and April of 2020, national sports were shutting down due to COVID-19, including the National Hockey League (NHL). While COVID-19 cases where blooming, it was unsafe for crowds to be in a building without masks. As they were just about to head into the playoffs, the NHL decided to close down until the case numbers dropped.

Starting August 1, 2020, the NHL formed a "bubble" in Canada with 24 teams. The eastern conference went to Toronto and the western conference went to Edmonton. As the teams lost games and were eliminated from the playoffs, they were allowed to leave the bubble. Each team was assigned to their own floor at a hotel.

Life in the bubble

The players woke up each morning and headed downstairs for breakfast. Every player also had a COVID-19 rapid test in the morning. It needed to be negative before they could enjoy the rest of their day. Once they got their negative test results, they were free to go about their day with activities in the hotel such as ping pong, swimming, reading, and so much more. There was a documentary made on their everyday life in the bubble called **Quest for the Stanley Cup**.

Its Game Time

After being stuck in the hotel all day, it was time to play some hockey at night. Teams shared locker rooms so their equipment was switched out with each game. At the stadium, there were no fans, just the players, coaches and referees. Teams who won games continued in the playoffs as usual. If a team lost, they went home to their families.

Towards the end of the playoffs at the finals, the winning team from the Edmonton bubble played the winning team from the Toronto bubble. The playoffs ended on September 28, 2020, with the Tampa Bay Lightning defeating the Dallas Stars four games to two in the Stanley Cup Finals. It was the second Stanley Cup in franchise history for Tampa Bay.

A late but new start?

When the 2019-20 season ended last September, COVID-19 cases were rising so they decided not to start the 2020-21 season as usual in October. On January 13, 2021, it was announced that the NHL will be back in session for the next season but this time, not in a bubble. Not all teams will play each other due to high risk. Let's see how the season goes.

The Amazing Platypus By Jessica Leek

Imagine you are wandering through the riverbanks of southern Australia, in hopes to see a unique and extraordinary animal. You hear a splash a couple of yards away. You turn your head to see nothing. Then, there is a strange animal gliding across the water. It is what you've been searching for - the platypus.

The platypus is an incredible animal with many special features. For instance, it is one of two monotremes left in the world, besides the echidna. A monotreme is an egg-laying mammal. The platypus has a flat beaver tail, a furry body like an otter and a beak like a duck. People could not believe their eyes when they saw it. They thought a person sewed two animals together as a joke. A typical male platypus is about 15 inches long, and the tail adds about 5 inches. They weigh about 3 pounds.

The webbed feet of a male platypus have pointy spurs on them that carry venom, which makes it one of the few mammals that have this feature. It is not deadly to humans but can cause swelling and much pain.

Platypuses only live in one small area on this earth - the freshwater islands of Tasmania and the southeast coast of Australia. They often dig burrows to live in, which have tunnels that contain chambers, like a house. They are most active at dusk or nighttime, which means they are nocturnal.

Platypuses are carnivores, meaning they eat meat. They scrape their beaks underwater while swimming to try and detect some kind of food. If they find shellfish, insects, larvae or worms, they store it in a pouch in their mouth until they break the surface of the water. Platypuses have no teeth, so they take in as much dirt as possible to help grind the tiny pieces of food in order to digest them.




When female platypuses are ready to give birth, they go inside their burrow, into a chamber and block the exit. They lay one or two eggs and place them between the tail and the body. After 10 days, the eggs hatch, and after 3 or 4 months of nursing, the baby platypuses will swim on their own.

As you can see, platypuses are a very unique animal, and are one of the strangest mammals alive. The list of features is endless. There are so many other amazing animals, so get exploring!

Here are some crazy fun facts about the amazing platypus.

- 1 The platypus uses its feet to steer, has waterproof fur, and has skin flaps that cover their eyes, nose and ears while swimming. Cool, right?
- 2 Though they are made for the water, they can only stay submerged under water up to 2 minutes.
- 3 Amazingly, scientists have proven that the platypuses have a bill that can sense electricity. That's right, electricity!
- 4 The platypus' fur is dense and waterproof, so it absorbs ultraviolet light. Scientists recently proved that it releases a fluorescent blue-green light off its fur. How cool is that!



Diving into the internet: Randonautica By Lee Daubaras

Ever heard of Randonautica? Most likely you heard it mentioned on the news at one point during the early summer or late spring of 2020. Normally, a simple app with no meaning on the surface calls for a rabbit hole, but it's not every day that one of them reaches mainstream news. Allow me to tell you the story, and my opinion, on the Randonautica incident.

It all started in February of 2020 when founder Joshua Lengfelder released an app with quite the backing on its subreddit and other places. This app, called Randonautica, is like a GPS but there is no set location. It is simple to use. Top Video Games of 2020 By Adam Menendez

In this article, I'll be recounting some of the more impactful and popular games of 2020. It is not in any particular list or format style, just writing about the games that I've heard the most about.

I'll start with a no-brainer, that being **Cyberpunk 2077**. Cyberpunk was a game that was hyped up endlessly. It was marked a classic before it was even released. It's about a city where all of its inhabitants are obsessed with power and glamour. You play as a mercenary outlaw named V who is looking for the key to immortality. The studio that created it, CD Projekt Red, delayed the release of the game a total of three times. Fans began to grow impatient and began to push for the game to be released sooner. It did finally release on December 10, 2020 and it was a good game for PC players. On the three other platforms it released on, it was so buggy people deemed the game unplayable, resulting in very mixed opinions.

Two games that did perform well in 2020 were **The Last of Us Two** and **Spiderman: Miles Morales**. Both were sequel games that were praised for their exceedingly good graphics and amazing story. I haven't played Miles Morales, but I have played its predecessor **Spider-Man** (PS4), which is one of my personal favorites, and I have heard that Miles Morales exceeded that game. **The Last of Us Two** is a game that has you playing through a post-apocalyptic USA. If there's one thing I've heard about this game, it's that the story is tragic, sad, and masterfully written.

One game that rose to fame and spread across social media like wildfire was Fall Guys, with its many stages that appeal to people playing online with friends. That game fell in popularity just as quickly as it arrived in light of another online multiplayer game, Among Us, that is still trending a couple months after its boom. Among Us is a game where ten players are grouped on a spaceship and they set out to complete tasks around the ship. If the task bar gets full then the crew wins. But in every game, there are one to three imposters aboard who can kill crewmates and sabotage the ship. If the imposters kill all the crewmates, they win. Everyone on the ship can vote someone off whenever an emergency meeting is called. If all the imposters are voted off, the crewmates get the win. If the imposter is smart enough, they can trick everyone into voting an innocent crewmate off. One can definitely see the appeal of this game in a combination of mind games and fun with friends.

Another game worth mentioning is **Ghost of Tsushima**. This is a graphically stunning game that has you playing a young samurai who follows a strict code of honor and goes on many quests. The game has a great story and the combat is satisfying and intense. It was a blast watching my favorite Youtubers play it and I probably would have been captivated by it as well if I had it myself.

The last game I want to mention is a role-playing game (RPG) called **Hades**. It's been described many times as roguelike, meaning that when the player dies, the character dies permanently. You play as the son of Hades, trying to escape the underworld. This list was constructed based on the things that I've heard throughout the internet, but when I did some more research, I found that **Hades** topped the list in three separate online articles, even though I had never heard of it. It has a great story like **The Last of Us** does and the great combat of **Ghost of Tsushima**. Hearing all this praise in my research makes me hope that it will become more popular on YouTube and Twitch so that I can see what they mean when they call it a masterpiece.

Those are the games that I thought I should include. Some honorable mentions also worth checking out are Call of Duty: Infinite Warfare, Animal Crossing: New Horizons, Valorant, and Half Life: Alyx.

Recipe: Strawberry Shortcakes By Madelyn Halter

SHORTCAKES

- 1. 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2. ¼ cup granulated sugar
- 3. 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 4. ¼ teaspoon salt
- 5. 6 tablespoons (¾ stick) cold unsalted butter, cut into small cubes
- 6. ¾ cup heavy cream

STRAWBERRIES

- 1. 1 pound fresh strawberries
- 2. 1 to 2 tablespoons granulated sugar

WHIPPED CREAM

- 1. 1 cup cold heavy cream
- 2. 1 tablespoon granulated sugar
- 3. 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 4. Powdered sugar, for serving



To make the shortcakes, preheat the oven to 375°F. Line a cookie sheet with a piece of parchment paper.

- 1 In a large bowl, whisk together the flour, granulated sugar, baking powder, and salt until evenly blended. Add the butter cubes. Using a pastry blender or 2 butter knives, cut the butter into the dry ingredients until the mixture looks like coarse crumbs, with some chunks the size of peas. Pour in the cream and stir with a wooden spoon until the dough starts to come together.
- **2 Sprinkle a work surface with flour.** Turn the dough out of the bowl and onto the floured surface and pat it into a disk. Roll it out with a rolling pin, giving the disk a quarter turn now and then, into a round slab that's 1 inch thick. Pat the sides to make them neat. Use a 3-inch biscuit cutter to cut out 4 rounds. Gather the dough scraps, roll them out just as you did before, and cut out 2 more rounds.
- **3 Set the dough rounds on the prepared cookie sheet,** evenly spacing them apart. Bake until the shortcakes are golden brown on top, 18 to 20 minutes. Ask an adult to help you remove the cookie sheet from the oven and set it on a wire rack. Let the shortcakes cool while you prepare the strawberries.
- **4 To prepare the strawberries**, put the berries on a cutting board. Ask an adult to help you cut out the stem and core from the center of each berry and cut the berries into wedges. Put the sliced berries into a medium bowl and sprinkle with the granulated sugar (the amount of sugar depends on how sweet the berries are- taste one!). Let the berries stand for 10 minutes.

- **5 To make the whipped cream**, in a large bowl, using an electric mixer, beat the cream, granulated sugar, and vanilla on low speed until the cream begins to thicken and no longer splatters, about 2 minutes. Raise the mixer-speed to medium high and continue to beat until the cream forms peaks that droop slightly when the beater(s) is lifted (turn off the mixer first), about 3 minutes.
- **6 Ask an adult to help you split each cooled shortcake** in half horizontally (if your cookies are thin, use two cookies instead) Place the shortcake bottoms on serving plates and spoon the strawberries on top, dividing them equally. Add a big spoonful of whipped cream and top with the shortcake tops. Put the powdered sugar in a fine-mesh sieve, hold it over each shortcake, and tap the side of the sieve to dust the shortcake with sugar. Serve right away.

Madelyn's Review

Personally, I loved them. They were not too sweet, and a great snack if you can put them together. The shortcakes are like cookies and they are very good. If I had to rate them, I would give it a 9/10. I loved them and I hope you enjoyed them too!

How to make Taco Dip:




- 1. First, spread one whole stick of cream cheese on the bottom of your pan evenly.
