Macedonia (FYROM) Finally Changes Its Name After Years Of Dispute

Above is the flag of North Macedonia.

In Southeastern Europe, in a region called the Balkans, lies a country whose name is very controversial to even say (or at least, that is how it used to be). This country, formerly known colloquially as Macedonia, or more officially as the Republic of Macedonia, and internationally referred to as the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (FYROM), has finally changed its name to North Macedonia after a longstanding dispute with Greece.

Macedonia has long been the name of a region in the Balkans, and this area covers the land of North Macedonia as well as Northern Greece and areas of surrounding countries. The country has been a source of debate for the last one hundred years.

In the First Balkan War (1912-13), the Ottoman Empire was pushed out of Macedonia and the region landed in the hands of Greece, Bulgaria, and Serbia. Macedonia was promised to Bulgaria, but Serbia and Greece decided to partition up the land between themselves instead. Bulgaria thus started the Second Balkan War (1913) to attack

Greece and Serbia, but they quickly lost and the status of Macedonia now lay with Greece and Serbia, much to Bulgaria's anger. During World War I, Bulgaria (along with Austria-Hungary and Germany) invaded Serbia and annexed (or added) much of Macedonia to their country. However, after World War I, Serbia united with other areas in the Balkans to create to create a new country that will later come to be known as the Kingdom of Yugoslavia.

At this point, much of
Macedonia was under the Vardar
Banovina subdivision (kind of
like a state or province) within
the country. After World War II,
Yugoslavia was re-established as
a socialist nation and the borders
of the modern day nation of
North Macedonia (known as the
People's Republic of
Macedonia) were formed.

In the early 1990s, Yugoslavia finally broke up through the long and bloody Yugoslav Wars that ravaged some of the other Yugoslav republics such as Croatia and Bosnia. North Macedonia's independence was the only one from Yugoslavia that was completely peaceful. However, trouble began almost immediately. Greece became upset by North Macedonia using the name "Macedonia" because Greece felt as if the country was trying to claim their history and possibly even their Macedonian territory (a northern region of Greece is called Macedonia).

Another thing that upset Greece was the use of a historically Greek symbol, the Vergina Sun, on the flag of the new country. This would be changed in 1995.

North Macedonia was finally allowed to join the United Nations in 1993 under the provisional (or temporary) name of the "Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia," as North Macedonia was a former republic of Yugoslavia. However, whenever the country was going to get around to changing its name, Greece was insistent on the idea that any name featuring the word "Macedonia" be rejected. They later relented and allowed for names featuring Macedonia (such as North Macedonia or Upper Macedonia) to be used in order to distinguish the nation. But the dispute took a long time to be solved. During this period of over 25 years, Greece (a member of the European Union and NATO, two international organizations) had blocked North Macedonia's entry into some organizations, which was not helping their development.

In June of 2018, the Prespa agreement between the two nations was reached and went into effect February 12, 2019. Overall, this move has been largely beneficial towards both nations. Greece can now be satisfied about the name, and the people of North Macedonia can still hold their heritage through their name (which was one of the major things preventing them from changing it). They are now eligible to join organizations like the EU and NATO, something that will help them both developmentally and economically.
