Movie Review - Avengers: Infinity War By Tyler Niles

(WARNING: Spoilers Ahead)

Avengers: Infinity War is the sequel to Avengers: Age of Ultron and is the 18th film in the Marvel Cinematic Universe (MCU). This movie has over 70 cast members and 22 heroes. The heroes are Captain America, Iron Man, the Hulk, Thor, Black Widow, Spider-Man, Falcon, Scarlett Witch, War Machine, Black Panther, Vision, Star-Lord, Rocket Raccoon, Drax, Gamora, Groot, Mantis, Nebula, Okoye, Winter Soldier (now being called White Wolf), Doctor Strange and Wong.

This film "is the Culmination of all of the MCU films before it" said Marvel Cinematic Universe CEO Kevin Feige. This movie has lots of action, suspense, horror and emotion. For an MCU fan, the ending of this movie is heartbreaking and it does not feel like a classic action movie ending.

The basic plot of the film is centered on Thanos, who is the main antagonist. His team is known as "The Black Order" in comics and includes Ebony Maw, Cull Obsidian, Proxima Midnight and Corvus Glaive. Their mission is to maintain all 6 of the Infinity Stones which consists of the Soul Stone, Mind Stone, Reality Stone, Time Stone, Power Stone and Space Stone.

MELISSA, THAT IS A SPOILER! BYE BYE. PLAY IT. PLEASE! -Katie



The Quarterly Gamer Corner By Johnathan Yankus



Argh, me mateys, ye be back for the last time to talk about **Sea of Thieves**, the brand new, pirate, action adventure game that is now available along with over 100+ other games on the Xbox game pass. Now, there has been some negative feedback toward this game saying that there's not enough gameplay in it, but I really like it. It's simple, it's fun, and most of the time it requires you to work online, either with friends you have now or friends yet to be.

The story is simple: you are a pirate and you must sail the Sea of Thieves and collect different artifacts for different orders that must be gained different ways. There are gold chests for the "Gold Hoarder" order, in which you buy a random quest, as with all the other unions, which give you either a map, a riddle or both. Then there's the "Order of Souls" where you collect skulls from skeletons (the main enemy in the game) that you find on different islands from wanted posters that you buy at their shack. Then finally there is the "Merchant" order (my least favorite). This one has you run to different islands to collect plants and animals to deliver them to customers within a certain amount of time. You can use either the sun or your watch to keep track of how many days have gone by.

There is also a way to select what ship you would like to use. There is the galleon, a sturdy ship with more cannons but is not as maneuverable as the sloop which can make tighter turns but requires less damage taken to sink it. The creators of the game are supposed to be adding more ships as well as more content, but for now the only thing you can buy are cosmetics for your ship or for your character. The combat system is great as well. The guns are slow and clunky just like real pirate guns were back then. There are also some tricks you can do with the sword, but I won't spoil the surprise.

Overall this is probably one of the best games I have ever played. It doesn't need a lot of lore to be fun (unlike **Overwatch**). The graphics are beautiful. The feeling of sailing across the ocean with your pals, plundering and pilfering really grabs you and is unlike anything I've

ever played before.
