What happens after you register on Naviance?

- The morning of your college visit, you will receive a pass to the counseling office.
- Most visits are in the career room in the counseling office.
- For some of the larger visits, we will have you go to a different room (the Flex Lab, #126, or the CHS auditorium once it reopens). Just check your pass to see if "Flex Lab" is written on it.

Why should I attend college visits at CHS?

- You will meet the person who will read your college application
- You can find out information about new scholarships or majors you might be interested in
- You can learn tips about what the admissions rep are looking for in the college application
- You can demonstrate your interest in that college (they usually collect names of students who attended)

COLLEGE VISIT POLICY

(when visiting a college off CHS campus)

Allowed three visits per year

Must complete paperwork prior to visit (pick up in CHS Counseling Office)

Must have college confirm your attendance


Does not count towards absences

APPLYING TO COLLEGE

- Apply online: go to the college's website, click on apply and see how they want you to apply (direct to the institution or through the Common App). Note application requirements.
- ALL APPLICATIONS at CHS MUST GO THROUGH NAVIANCE so if you have applied directly to an institution, request your official transcript sent there through Naviance
- Reach schools, Match schools, Safety schools.
- Beware of deadlines:
 Early Action deadline is November 1st
- Check out this video guiding you through the application process and Naviance.


Start by adding colleges to your list in your Naviance account. Naviance is a great platform to use to learn about universities and find which is the right fit for you.

If applying directly to the university, follow the prompts on the university's website to apply (reminder you will still need to request your transcript via Naviance, so add them to your list).


If applying via common app, go to www.commonapp.org and create an account



Most students will be using Common App to apply to colleges (most schools use common app). Again, you will have to research to find out which schools do and which schools don't.

Once you create your Common App account, you link your Common App to your Naviance account.

Some schools have no application fee during certain times in October. We will send you emails as we become aware of schools that offer this. Be sure to do your own research as well.





LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION


- If a letter of recommendation is required, ask for one from an academic teacher
- ALL LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION requests to teachers at CHS MUST GO THROUGH NAVIANCE (after you have asked the teacher in person) do not add recommenders to Common App
- Give teachers 2-4 weeks time to write, so you can have a quality letter of recommendation
- Letters of recommendation are sent to all the colleges you are applying to
- Letters of recommendation from counselors
 IF REQUIRED (or special circumstances) Senior Information Sheet form in counseling office

Recommendations – if requested

Sending Test Scores

- Many, many colleges are now test optional!
- If official test scores are required, they need to be sent from College Board or ACT directly.
- Some colleges will allow you to self report the score during the application process, but you will have to send the official score from College Board once you accept the offer.
- We can't send your scores
- Send all of your scores
- If you plan to test this fall, put the dates in on your applications


