CONTEST RULES

Wall art may not exceed 40 inches wide by 40 inches high.

Wall art must identify and/or depict the issue of single use plastic and possible solutions the public can act on.

Environmental Commission members highly encourage schools to use these pieces to educate their entire school about the issues with plastics and how we all can be part of the solution.
