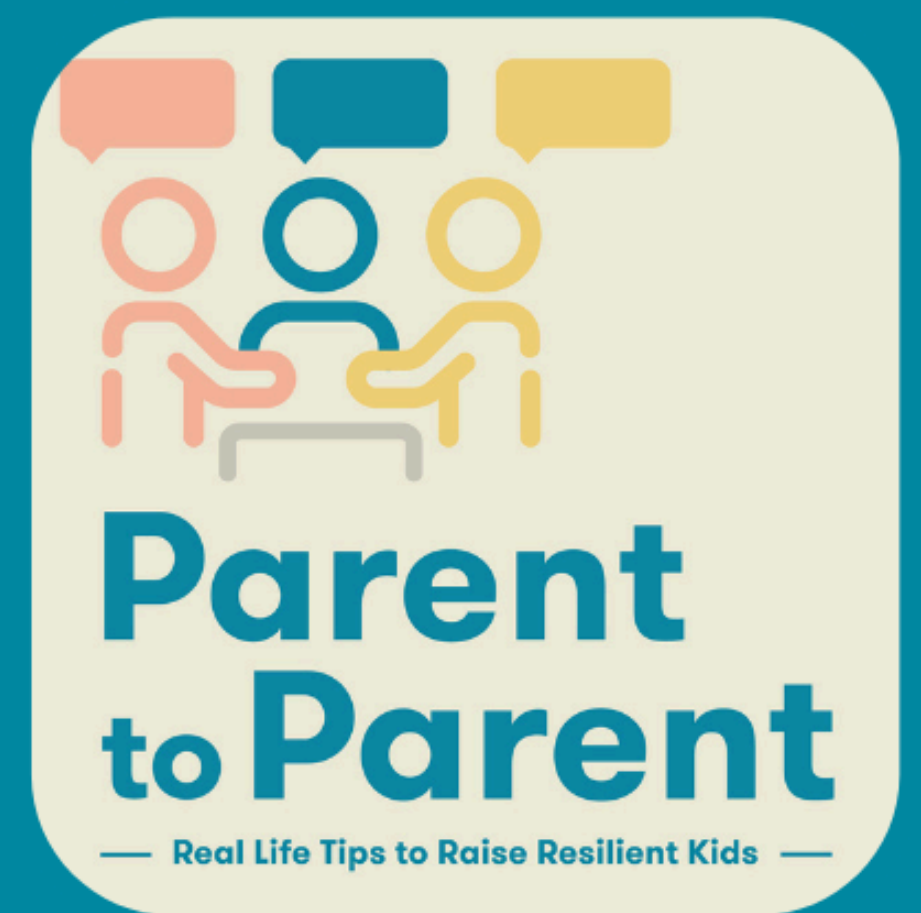


JOIN US FOR...
