3h. RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board and Union are parties to a collective negotiations agreement governing the terms and conditions of employment for all regularly employed non-teaching certificated employees of the South Bergen Jointure Commission (hereinafter referred to as “Outreach Employees”) for the period beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2025 (hereinafter referred to as the “Agreement”);

WHEREAS, Article XIV of the Agreement provides that:

B. All eligible Employees hired prior to July 1, 2020 shall be eligible to participate in any of the plans offered in the SEHBP. If an eligible Employee enrolls in Direct 10,

he/she shall pay the difference in premiums between Direct 10 and Direct 15.

WHEREAS, the Union has requested that Article XIV, Section B be deferred for a period of time; and

WHEREAS, although there is not an obligation to grant the Union's request, the Board is willing to defer the implementation of Article XIV, Section B until January 1, 2023;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board approves the Side Bar Agreement which memorializes the parties' agreement to defer the implementation of Article XIV, Section B until January 1, 2023.
