1. Pass a certain # of certain types of classes (4 years of English, for example).



2. Demonstrate competence in English and math by passing Performance Measures.

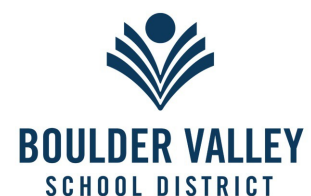

September 6, 2024 Apply to be in the BVSD Community Leadership Academy

For the third year, the Boulder Valley School District will be hosting the [BVSD Community Leadership Academy](#), in partnership with Parent Engagement Network. The program is an opportunity for parents and community members to deepen their understanding of the Boulder Valley School District and our work.
