



Instructions:

2. Format your spreadsheet using borders and read, white, or blue colors. Insert a graphic related to the presidential seal, presidents, or government.
3. After all information is entered, perform filters to get a list of Presidents in each party. You will need to perform how many filters? _____. Please print a copy of each filter performed.
4. At the bottom of the spreadsheet, enter a table to list each party and the number of presidents in each party.
5. Add a password to protection your document so that no changes can be made. Hint: Click review tab, protect sheet, make sure "Protect worksheet and contents of locked cells" is checked at the top. Enter a password and click ok. Now exit document, load it back on screen and attempt to change something. You should not be able to make changes if your password worked!!



6. Save your worksheet as **Presidents**. You will use this file in the next unit to create a spreadsheet chart of the president parties in graph form.
